

Construction Update – Central Station

April to May 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown, with new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Gadigal and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central. By 2030, Sydney will have a network of four metro lines, 46 stations, and 113km of new metro rail. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Laing O'Rourke delivered the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney's busiest railway station.

Upcoming weekend and Out of hours work (in April and May 2024)

Saturday, 27 April and Sunday, 28 April (6am-6pm) the following work will occur:

- On Platform 12, repairing roof canopy joint seals.

From 10pm Wednesday, 1 May to 4am Thursday 2 May, the following work will occur:

- On Platform 20, hi-rail delivery of equipment and installation of ATF fencing. The evening of Thursday 2 May is contingency for this delivery.

From 6am Saturday, 4 May, to 10pm Sunday, 5 May, the following work will occur:

- On Platform 16-21, defect rectification for tiling, painting and Guard rooms (external only).
- On Platforms 20-21, drainage defect rectification.

From 10pm Monday, 6 May to 4am Tuesday 7 May, the following work will occur:

- On Platform 20, hi-rail removal of equipment. The evening of Tuesday 7 May is contingency for this delivery.

From late Friday, 10 May, to early Monday, 13 May (around the clock) the following work will occur:

- On Platform 16-21, defect rectification for tiling, painting and within Guards rooms.
- On Platforms 14, repairing roof canopy joint seals.

Saturday, 25 May (6am-6pm) and Sunday, 26 May (6am-6pm) the following work will occur:

- On Platform 12, repairing roof canopy joint seals.
- On Sydney Yard Access Bridge, painting and rust removal. Note these works will be undertaken Saturday, 25 May (7am-6pm) and Sunday, 26 May (8am-6pm).

Bike rack installation at the Central Station Elizabeth Street entrance/exit

22 bike hoops will be installed outside the Elizabeth Street entrance/exit to Central Station, providing parking space for 44 bicycles.

Construction activities to install the hoops will take place from **Monday 6 May to Monday 20 May 2024, weather permitting**. All works will be undertaken within standard working hours, 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 8am-1pm Saturday.

Equipment used for the work will include a concrete saw, small jackhammer, hand tools and power tools.
