

Notification – St Marys

St Marys Station footbridge

March 2024

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

Work will continue over the next month for the new station footbridge.

Standard work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and from **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

What work are we doing in March?

During the month, activities will include spoil removal from work areas, fencing installation, vegetation removal, utility investigation and relocation, and work area preparation for upcoming weekend work.

Outside of standard hours work in March

From **1am Saturday 16 March** until **1am Monday 18 March**, we will be working continuously during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend.

Activities during this weekend include:

- Crane set up and removal (within the work area on Harris Street)
- Relocation of overhead wiring
- Piling work on all platforms to provide foundational support
- Asphaltting to restore work areas

Where we'll be working

We will be working on Harris Street, Forrester Road, on the station platforms, within the rail corridor and in the vicinity of the multi-storey commuter car park on Harris Street. Three laydown areas within the rail corridor, accessed

from Hobart Street near Australia Street and the Terminal Access Road will be used to store construction materials and equipment.

What to expect

- An increase in workers and vehicles around our work areas and on local roads, especially during our weekend work from 1am Friday 16 March until 1am Monday 19 March.
- Traffic control and signage to assist pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists, as required.
- Some noise and vibration from machinery and equipment.
- Temporary removal of parking along Harris Street during utility investigation work.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to reduce the impact to the community and the environment. This includes:

- Turning off equipment when not in use
- Noise and vibration monitoring to ensure levels do not exceed those anticipated at the closest residential receivers
- Most of our work in March will occur during standard construction hours only

Equipment

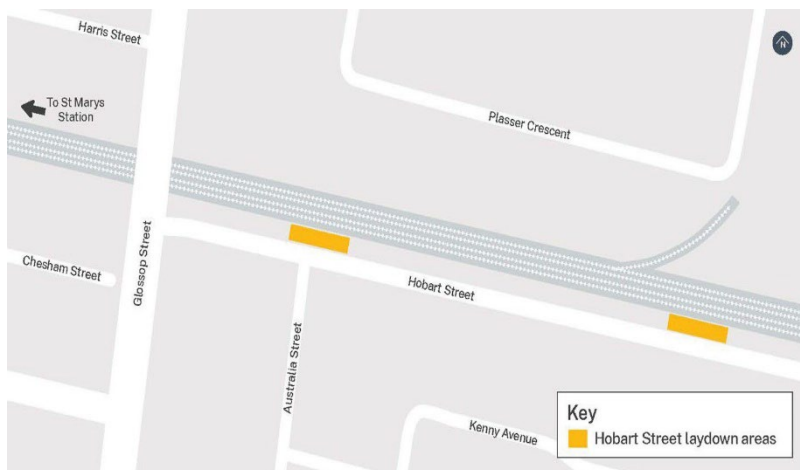
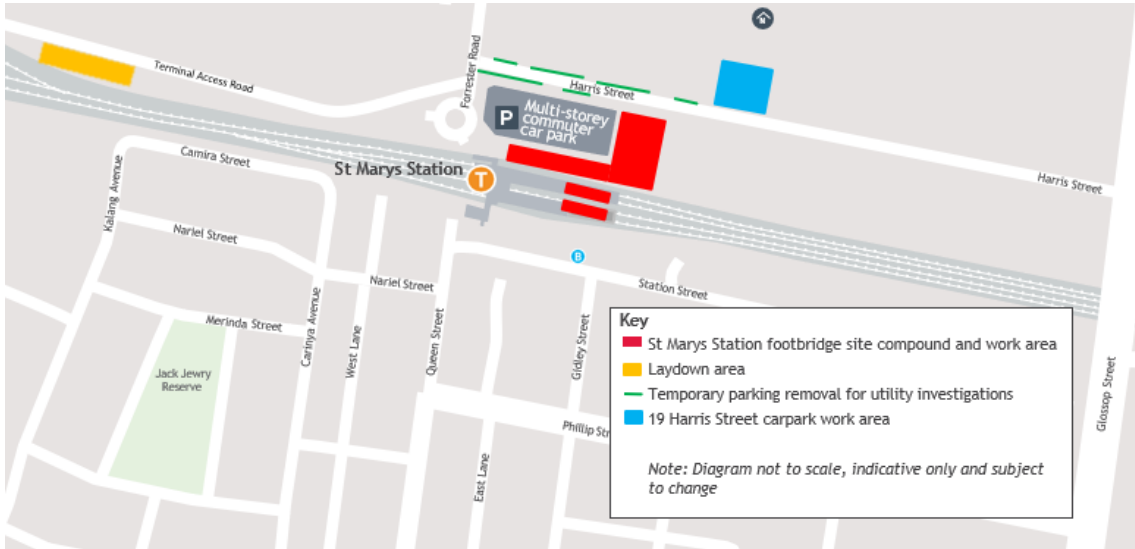
Equipment to be used includes drills, demolition saws, excavators, saw cutters, dump trucks, front end loaders, vacuum trucks, semi-trailers and rigid trucks, concrete trucks, mobile crane, light towers, power tools, survey equipment and hand tools.



Four-month lookahead – outside of standard construction hours:

Activity	Timing (Sydney Trains trackwork weekend)
Relocation of overhead wiring, piling, crane set up and removal.	1am Saturday 16 March until 1am Monday 18 March
Platform hoarding installation, concrete work including piling	1am Saturday 27 April until 1am Monday 29 April 2024.
Concrete work including piling	1am Saturday 18 May until 1am Monday 20 May 2024.
