SYDNEY METRO NORTHWEST CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – BALMORAL STORAGE YARD

The \$8.3 billion Sydney Metro Northwest is the first stage of Sydney Metro - Australia's biggest public transport project currently under construction and a priority infrastructure investment for the NSW Government. Salini Impregilo has been contracted to build the 4 kilometre elevated skytrain component of Sydney Metro Northwest, including a new cable stayed bridge over Windsor Road at Rouse Hill.

The Sydney Metro Northwest skytrain team visited today to discuss works taking place at the segment storage yard between Balmoral Road and Memorial Avenue, Kellyville.

Neighbours can expect to see excess concrete being demolished in this area. Demolition material will then be loaded onto trucks and removed from the site. Jack hammering and segment crushing is expected to be complete by **13 October 2017**.

This activity will take place during standard construction hours only, **Monday to Friday** between **7.00am – 5.30pm** and on **Saturdays 8.00am – 1.00pm**.

There will be general earthworks and demobilisation activities in this location until the **end of October 2017**.
