SYDNEY METRO NORTHWEST – OPERATIONS, TRAINS AND SYSTEMS UPDATE: Sydney Metro Trains Facility – Installation of services – Gordon Road and Oak Street

The \$8.3 billion Sydney Metro Northwest is the first stage of Sydney Metro – Australia's biggest public transport project. The Northwest Rapid Transit Consortium (NRT) is delivering eight new railway stations, 23km of new track, 4,000 commuter parking spaces and Sydney's new generation of safe, reliable and fully automated metro trains. NRT will deliver this critical infrastructure and operate and maintain it for 15 years.

As part of the construction for Sydney Metro Trains Facility, work is continuing to connect into existing services on Gordon Road and Oak Street (See map overleaf).

These service installation works will continue to be undertaken in normal construction hours (**Monday – Friday 7am to 6pm** and **Saturdays 8am to 1pm**) and will take approximately **8 weeks** to complete. In the event of wet weather, machinery breakdown or other unforeseen circumstances, work timeframes may be extended.

There will be noise associated with these works and temporary lane closures will be required. Drivers should drive carefully through road work zones, follow directions of traffic controllers, adhere to reduced speed limits and follow traffic signs.

What to expect during these works?

- Delivery of materials and equipment
- Traffic control and pedestrian management
- Use of equipment and machinery including excavators, an underbore machine, saw cutter, compactor and trucks
- Construction noise associated with these works
- Construction vehicle movements including flashing vehicle lights and non-tonal reversing beepers for the safety of workers
- Clearing of vegetation in line with environmental approvals


What we will do to minimise the impacts?

- Minimise the need for vehicles to reverse
- Implementation of traffic controls
- Use measures to minimise noise impacts from general plant and equipment such as non-tonal reversing alarms and turning off plant and equipment when not in use.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- The Sydney Metro Northwest will be delivered as part of Sydney's Rail Future – a customer-focused plan to modernise our trains. Over the coming decades, an extra 200,000 people will move into the region, taking its population above 600,000.
- New automated single deck trains will deliver a fast, safe and reliable service.
- There will be no need for a timetable – customers will just turn up and go, with a train every four minutes in the peak.
- The project includes 15km of tunnels between Bella Vista and Epping, a 4km skytrain viaduct section and the conversion of the existing Epping to Chatswood rail link to the new metro system.

 - Converting the existing 13 km Epping and Chatswood line to metro status
 - The operation and maintenance of the Sydney Metro Northwest
