

## Sydney Metro Northwest - Fire and Rescue NSW equipment test

The \$8.3 billion Sydney Metro Northwest is the first stage of Sydney Metro – Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro services will start in the second quarter of 2019.

As part of testing and commissioning the new railway, Fire and Rescue NSW will be testing aerial fire fighting equipment this **Saturday 10 November 2018** between 9am and 12 noon at the Kellyville Station site.

The purpose of this notification is to advise you of the presence of emergency vehicles and personnel in the area for this test.

### What to expect:

- Approximately 20 emergency service workers on the skytrain near the T-way car park at Samantha Riley Drive, Kellyville
- A piece of aerial fire fighting equipment will be in use
- Please note no sirens will be used
