

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services start in 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms under Central.

The NSW Government has awarded a \$955 million contract to Laing O’Rourke to deliver the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney’s busiest railway station.

Upcoming work at Central Station

From early January to early February, work will continue in the following areas:

- Building and completing new stairs on platforms 20-21 and 22-23
- Preparing piling foundations and excavating within platform 13, 14 and 15, for the new underground metro station
- Installing hoarding and services investigations on the Northern Concourse and Grand Concourse
- Extending platforms 9,10 and 11
- Overhead wiring and track adjustments around platforms 9-12 and 15-16
- Installing site facilities in Sydney Yard
- Construction of new Sydney Trains staff rooms on platforms 18-19 and 20-21
- Removal of Sydney Yard Access Bridge site facilities on Regent Street
- Services and materials investigations within and in front of 20-28 Chalmers Street and around station concourses and tunnels.

Standard working hours

Standard working hours are Monday to Friday, 7am–6pm and Saturday, 8am–1pm.

Out-of-hours work

Out-of-hours work will occur from early January through to Friday 8 February. Out-of-hours are Monday to Friday 6pm to 7am, Friday 6pm to Saturday 8am and weekends Saturday 1pm through to Monday 7am.

Due to the nature of some activities, to minimise impacts to customers and for the safety of workers, some work will occur outside standard construction hours when trains are not running.

Out-of-hours	Activities (subject to approval)
Saturday 2 – Sunday 3 February (48 hours continuous)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Locating services on platform 22-23 and track 23.

Site access

- Machinery and material deliveries will be made via the Sydney Yard Access Bridge located at Regent Street.
- Deliveries to the loading dock off Pitt Street will occur each evening and overnight.
- Some high-rail vehicles will access the rail corridor via Chalmers, Elizabeth and Gibbons street entrances.
- This work is planned to be undertaken outside of standard construction hours to coincide with Sydney Trains scheduled maintenance periods.

What to expect

- To minimise noise, high-noise generating activities are scheduled where possible during daytime hours.
- Machinery used during the month include: crawler cranes, piling rigs, excavators, vacuum truck, concrete trucks, tipper trucks and construction vehicles, hand and power tools including jack hammer and concrete saw.
