

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services start in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

The NSW Government has awarded a \$955 million contract to Laing O'Rourke Australia Construction Pty Ltd to deliver the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney's busiest railway station.

Service investigation work – Surry Hills

Service investigation work will be undertaken in front of 20-28 Chalmers Street in Surry Hills on **Monday 7 January** (7am - 6pm) and **Tuesday 8 January** (7am - 6pm), weather and site conditions permitting. This work is non-invasive and involves identifying and marking any underground utilities. See map overleaf for location details.

Work will involve:

- Saw cutting in front of 20-28 Chalmers Street.

Standard working hours

- Standard working hours are Monday to Friday, 7am–6pm and Saturday, 8am–1pm.

What to expect

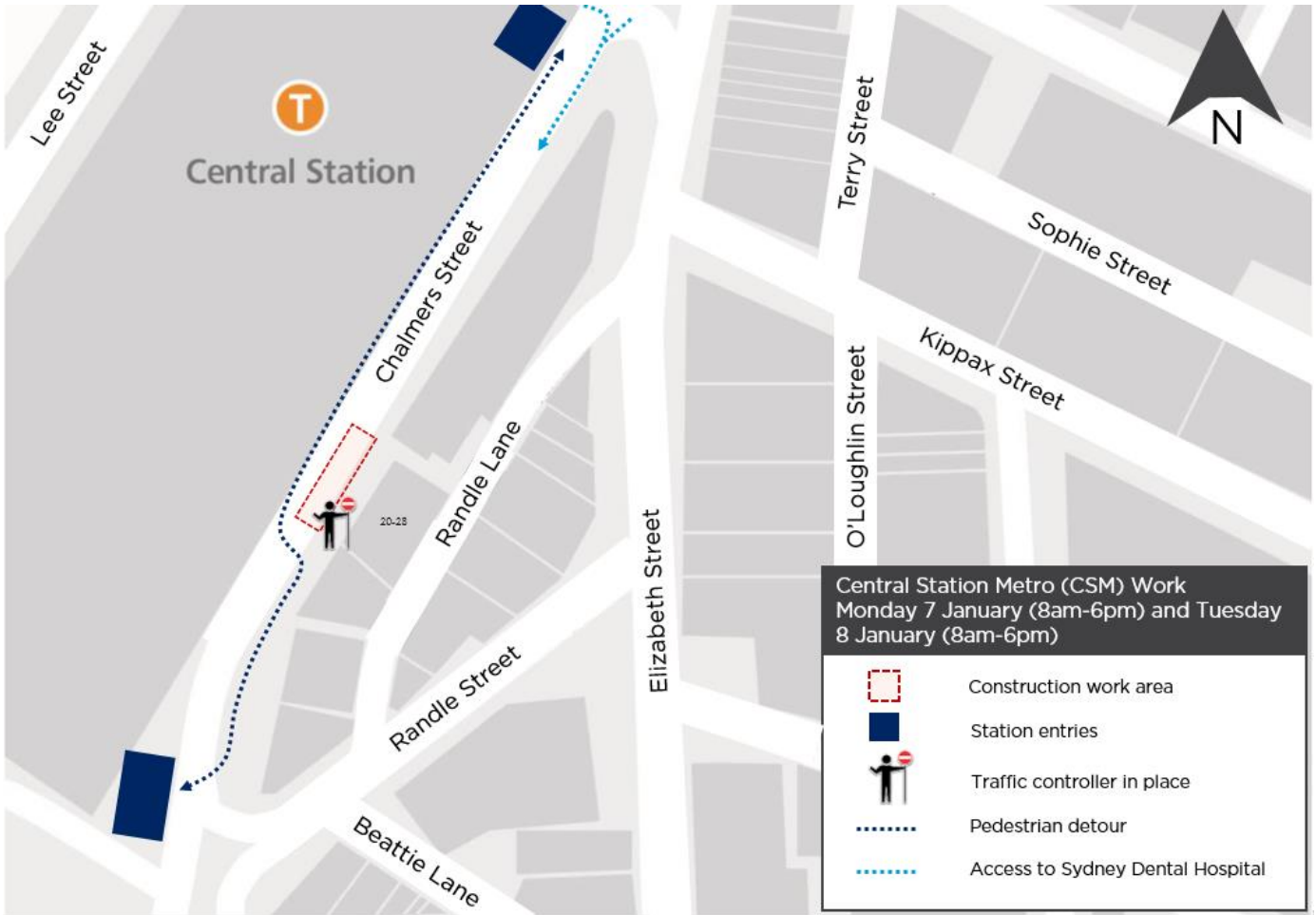
- Work will be undertaken within the Sydney Light Rail site area.
- Traffic control will be in place throughout the work to safely guide local traffic, pedestrians, and other road users around the work.
- Due to the nature of the work some of these activities will be noisy at times. The team will limit impacts wherever possible by turning off machinery when not in use.
- Machinery used during this work includes concrete saw, vacuum truck and construction vehicles.
