

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services start in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

The NSW Government has awarded a \$955 million contract to Laing O'Rourke Australia Construction Pty Ltd to deliver the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney's busiest railway station.

Removal of site facilities at Sydney Yard Access Bridge

Sydney Metro Sydney Yard Access Bridge site facilities will be removed from behind Mortuary Station starting from Monday 14 January 2019. The work is expected to take two weeks and will be undertaken within standard working hours. This site will then be returned to Sydney Trains.

Work will involve:

- Disconnecting services and removing timber covered areas and stairs
- Lifting site offices and generator using a small mobile crane onto trucks within the STA Bus Depot on Regent Street
- Laying ballast on the ground within the site using a small excavator
- Installing fencing to secure the site.

Standard working hours

Standard working hours are Monday to Friday, 7am–6pm and Saturday, 8am–1pm.

What to expect

- Site facilities will be loaded by crane onto trucks within the site between Wednesday 16 and Friday 18 January
- Trucks will wait to be loaded within the STA bus depot
- Work is not expected to be noisy and will be carried out within standard construction hours
- Construction traffic within the bus depot will be operating under traffic control and will leave the depot via the traffic lights onto Regent Street.
