

Sydney Metro Northwest Parking Management Implementation – Notification

In 2018 Sydney Metro prepared a Northwest Parking Management Strategy that addresses key parking considerations across the project, such as commuter parking, impact to on-street parking and appropriate responses to parking issues. Sydney Metro proposed a number of changes and restrictions to local on-street parking as part of this strategy. Community feedback on the proposed changes was sought in December 2018.

Parking sign installation

The work to install new parking signs on the Council strip of land in your area/street will commence on **Monday 18 March, 2019 and take around three weeks to complete**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Works will involve:

- The installation of parking restriction and zone signage
- The use of vacuum excavation to dig post holes for the signs.

Hours of work

The works will be completed during standard construction hours, Monday to Friday between 7am and 5pm.

What to expect

- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community
- The noise from these activities is expected to be minimal
- Access to homes and driveways will be maintained at all times.
