

Sydney Metro is a new world-class railway for Sydney. The \$8.3 billion Sydney Metro Northwest is the first stage of Sydney Metro – Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services start in the north west in the middle of 2019 on Australia’s first fully-automated railway, with 13 metro stations and 4000 new commuter car parking spaces. A new generation of metro trains will run every four minutes in the peak in each direction. Customers won’t need a timetable, they’ll just turn up and go.

Sydney’s fast, safe and reliable metro trains are fully-air conditioned with new customer benefits like multi-purpose spaces for luggage and parents with prams, as well as wheelchair spaces and priority seating in each carriage.

As part of preparations for the new service, Sydney Metro proposes to upgrade transport interchanges at Epping, North Ryde, Macquarie Park, Macquarie University and Chatswood stations to help improve safety and make public transport more accessible.

Sydney Metro is proposing a No Parking zone on Langston Place to allow drivers to stop for up to two minutes, or five minutes if a disabled permit is displayed, to pick up or drop off passengers, providing the driver stays within three metres of their vehicle. Formal kiss and ride zones provide a safe, legal location for people to drop off or pick up passengers, without using No Stopping or Bus Zones.

Sydney Metro also plans to upgrade the bus stops on Beecroft Road to make them Disability Discrimination Act compliant, and align with current transport standards. To do these works, the bus stop locations need to be adjusted slightly. This adjustment requires the removal of some parking spaces to allow adequate space for buses to pick up and set down passengers. The diagram overleaf shows the proposed parking changes.

Have your say

Sydney Metro is undertaking public consultation on the proposed changes. The outcomes of this consultation will form part of a submission to Roads and Maritime Services and the City of Parramatta Council, who will assess the proposed changes.

The community is invited to comment on the proposals until **Monday, 8 April 2019**.


