

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services start in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Laing O'Rourke is delivering the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney's busiest railway.

## Site establishment – Chalmers Street, Surry Hills

The construction of the **new entrance to Central Station at 20-28 Chalmers Street** is now underway. To enable this, a work site will be established outside of standard construction hours at 20-28 Chalmers Street. (See map overleaf.)

- **Saturday 13 April and Sunday 14 April (6am-10pm)**, work will include installation of hoarding and site amenities. Minimal activities are expected at night however contingency time has been included to ensure the work can be completed during this weekend.

### What to expect

- From Saturday 13 April (6am) until Sunday 14 April (10pm), the pedestrian footpath immediately in front of 20-28 Chalmers Street will be temporary closed during site establishment. Pedestrians and cyclists will be redirected to use the footpath on the other side of Chalmers Street.
- On Sunday 14 April, a crane will be set up on Chalmers Street to allow site amenities to be lifted into position on top of the hoarding at 20-28 Chalmers Street.
- While work is undertaken, traffic control will be in place throughout the work to safely guide local traffic, pedestrians and other road users around the work.
- Some construction vehicles will be moving around Chalmers Street for deliveries and work.
- Due to the nature of the work, some activities will be noisy and will impact pedestrian access at times. We will ensure disruptions are minimised as much as possible.
- Machinery used during the work includes crane, drilling rig, truck mounted crane, forklift, construction vehicles and trucks along with hand and power tools.

While work is being undertaken, it is **business as usual** for retailers, cafes, restaurants and the Sydney Dental Hospital on Chalmers Street. Access to these businesses will be maintained.

### Standard working hours

Standard working hours are Monday to Friday, 7am–6pm and Saturday, 8am–1pm.

### Out-of-hours work


