

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services start in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

The T3 Bankstown Line is being upgraded and converted to metro standards between Sydenham and Bankstown with all stations to be fully accessible with lifts and level access between platforms and trains. The upgrade of the T3 Bankstown Line to metro standards received planning approval on 19 December 2018.

## Ground surveys and investigations

Throughout April and May, ground/ecology surveys and visual investigations will be carried out **between Bankstown and Yagoona** stations. Work will involve:

- Visual Inspections of stations and assets such as track, bridges and drainage from inside the rail corridor and nearby public areas
- Survey activities along public footpaths and in parks adjacent to the rail corridor

### Standard working hours

This work will be carried out during standard construction hours which are Monday to Friday, 7am–6pm and Saturday, 8am–1pm.

### What to expect

- Equipment will include hand held surveying and scanning equipment
- Access to the rail corridor will be via existing rail corridor gates along the alignment
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times
