

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5 kilometre long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations, including one at Pitt Street.

Upcoming work at Pitt Street Station sites

Heritage investigations, piling and site establishment activities will continue in June at Pitt Street South. In the underground station caverns from the Pitt Street North site waterproofing and permanent lining of the tunnels will progress. The table below provides more information about activities planned for June 2019, weather and site conditions permitting.

Standard construction hours are Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturday between 8am and 1pm. Due to high daytime traffic volumes and to ensure pedestrian safety, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. Out-of-hours work will occur 8pm–5am Monday to Friday for up to three nights per week and 10 nights per month. Underground work and work inside the acoustic shed at Pitt Street North may occur 24 hours a day.

What to expect

- Respite periods from high impact noise during construction hours at Pitt Street South: Monday to Friday 7am-9am, 11am-12pm, 2pm-3pm, 5:30pm-6pm; and Saturday 11am-12pm.

- Temporary traffic changes, lane closures, traffic control and directional signage may be in place for the safety of workers and the community.
- Pedestrian footpaths may be narrowed and closed in some instances, with alternate routes provided.
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.


