

Sydney Metro is Australia's largest public transport project

The NSW Government is conducting geotechnical investigations for the Sydney Metro Greater West project.

Sydney Metro Greater West is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport.

The new railway will include stations at the airport, Western Sydney Aerotropolis, and St Marys – where customers can connect with the rest of Sydney's existing suburban rail network.

World-class metro rail means better access to more places, faster travel times, less congestion on roads and a reduced reliance on cars.

Metro services start in May 2019 in the city's North West between Rouse Hill and Chatswood and will be extended into the Sydney CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Detailed investigations are also taking place for Sydney Metro West, which will link the CBDs of Parramatta and Sydney and communities along the way in around 20 minutes.

Geotechnical work – St Marys

Essential geotechnical investigations are taking place to assist with the planning and design of Sydney Metro Greater West. These investigations are required to determine the underlying ground and groundwater conditions.

Work is expected to start in the week beginning **Monday, 20 May 2019** in a section of the St Marys Commuter Car Park, adjacent to the Sydney Trains railway station. Work will take about **two weeks** to complete (weather and site conditions permitting).

Work will involve

- Establishing a temporary site, involving the use of up to ten parking spaces adjacent to the railway station
- A mobile rig to drill a borehole to below ground level
- Vacuum excavation truck to remove spoil from site
- An increase in light vehicle movements
- Following the investigations, technicians will carry out periodic groundwater monitoring for up to one year. The monitoring will not impact on car parking spaces.

What to expect

Access to the car park will be maintained and the majority of car parking spaces will be unaffected during the work.

The ground surface will be reinstated at completion of the work.

The noise impact from these activities is expected to be minimal with most geotechnical work taking place during standard construction hours, which are **Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday 8am-1pm**.


If work is required outside these hours, notification will be provided in advance.
