

**UPDATE: Geotechnical investigations (new start date)**

Geotechnical investigation work is being undertaken to assist with early planning and design work for Sydney Metro West in the Clyde/Rosehill area. This work is required to determine underlying rock conditions.

**Please note:** This work was scheduled to commence on **Friday 21 June**. Due to site conditions work will now commence on **Monday 24 June** and is expected to be completed by **Tuesday 6 August 2019**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work is being done during standard construction hours which are **Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday 8am-1pm**.

Work will be occurring in the following areas:

<b>Area 1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unwin Street</li> <li>• Shirley Street</li> </ul>
<b>Area 2</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kay Street</li> <li>• Wentworth Street</li> <li>• Unwin Street (adjacent to James Ruse Drive)</li> </ul>
<b>Area 3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tennyson Street</li> <li>• Deniehy Street</li> </ul>

**Work will include:**

- Establishing a temporary site with site fencing
- Using a truck mounted drill rig to bore below ground level
- Removing spoil from site using a vacuum excavation truck
- Reinstating the area at completion of the work
- Technicians using hand held devices to carry out monthly site monitoring for up to six months.

**What to expect:**

- Noise impact from these activities is expected to be minimal
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community
- Access to pathways, buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.
- There is potential that contaminated material may be found in the area and our crews will be wearing appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE). If any hazardous material is located, it will be removed in a safe controlled manner and in accordance with the SafeWork NSW Code of Practice.
