

NOTIFICATION – MARTIN PLACE | 15 JULY 2019

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66km standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella Joint Venture (JHCPBG) has been awarded the contract to build the twin railway tunnels from Chatswood to Sydenham and excavate six new Sydney Metro stations.

Macquarie Group will deliver the new Sydney Metro Martin Place integrated station development and has appointed Lendlease as its design and construction contractor.

Out-of-hours works – Martin Place South hoarding graphics

Hoarding has recently been changed on the Elizabeth Street side of the Martin Place Station South site.

Graphics will be installed onto the new hoarding at night on **Monday 22 July 2019** (weather and site conditions permitting).

Work will involve:

- Setting up the work area
- Minor structural work, painting and attaching graphics using hand and power tools
- Reinstating the work area.

Work hours

Due to high daytime traffic volumes and to ensure pedestrian safety, this work needs to be completed outside standard construction hours. Work is scheduled to occur between **10pm and 6am on Monday 22 July 2019**.

What to expect

- Due to the nature of the work, some of these activities will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible.
- Temporary pedestrian diversions will be in place around the work area. Directional signage will be in place for the safety of the workers and the community.
- Access to building and driveways will be maintained at all times.
- Equipment used during these works will include but is not limited to hand tools, power tools and ladders.
