

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella Joint Venture (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5-kilometre-long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations.

Upcoming out-of-hours work – Artarmon substation

Some out-of-hours work is required in September at the Artarmon substation site to disconnect a sewer line. This work needs to be done out-of-hours due to high daytime traffic volumes in the area and to ensure that daytime access to businesses on Reserve Road and Whiting Street is maintained.

An indicative map of the work area is provided overleaf.

The work is scheduled to take place over 3 nights from 8pm-5am in the week beginning **Monday 9 September**. If weather or site conditions do not allow the work to be completed it will be rescheduled for the week beginning **Monday 16 September**.

Work will involve:

- Delivering and unloading equipment and establishing the work area
- Installing pedestrian detours and traffic control
- Opening sewer manholes around the work area
- Using CCTV to locate the underground sewer line and using robotic equipment to disconnect it
- The possible use of a vacuum truck to clear out work areas so that the sewer line is accessible
- Reinstating road and pavement surfaces on completion of work as required

What to expect

- Although this work is considered low impact, there may be some noisier activities. We will make every effort to reduce the impact of noisy work by using non-tonal reversing beepers, turning off equipment when not in use, and completing noisier activities prior to midnight.
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained.
- There will no impact to the sewer and systems in surrounding buildings.
