

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services start in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5 kilometre long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations, including one at Barangaroo.

Hickson Road – temporary night road closures

Hickson Road will be temporarily closed between Towns Place and Watermans Quay for two nights so that large tunnel boring machines components can be safely moved between construction sites. Weather permitting, these temporary road closures will be in place from:

- **Midnight Sunday 17 to 5am Monday 18 November 2019**
- **Midnight Monday 18 to 5am Tuesday 19 November 2019**

If the work cannot be completed during these dates, additional night road closures will occur later in the week.

A detour will be in place via Towns Place, Dalgety Road, Kent Street and Napoleon Street. Bus services 311, 324 and 325 will be rerouted via this detour. There will be some changes to bus stops, including temporary bus stops near the corner of Kent Street and High Street. These bus stops will service the 311, 324 and 325 bus services.

Directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community. Please refer to the map over the page for details about the detour route and changes to bus services.

Work will involve:

- Setting up a temporary worksite, including safety and environmental controls
- Moving large equipment from the main Barangaroo Station site to the eastern side of Hickson Road
- Packing up and demobilising the work site.

Work hours

Due to high daytime traffic volumes, the nature of activities and to ensure pedestrian safety, this work will be carried out between **12am and 5am**.

What to expect

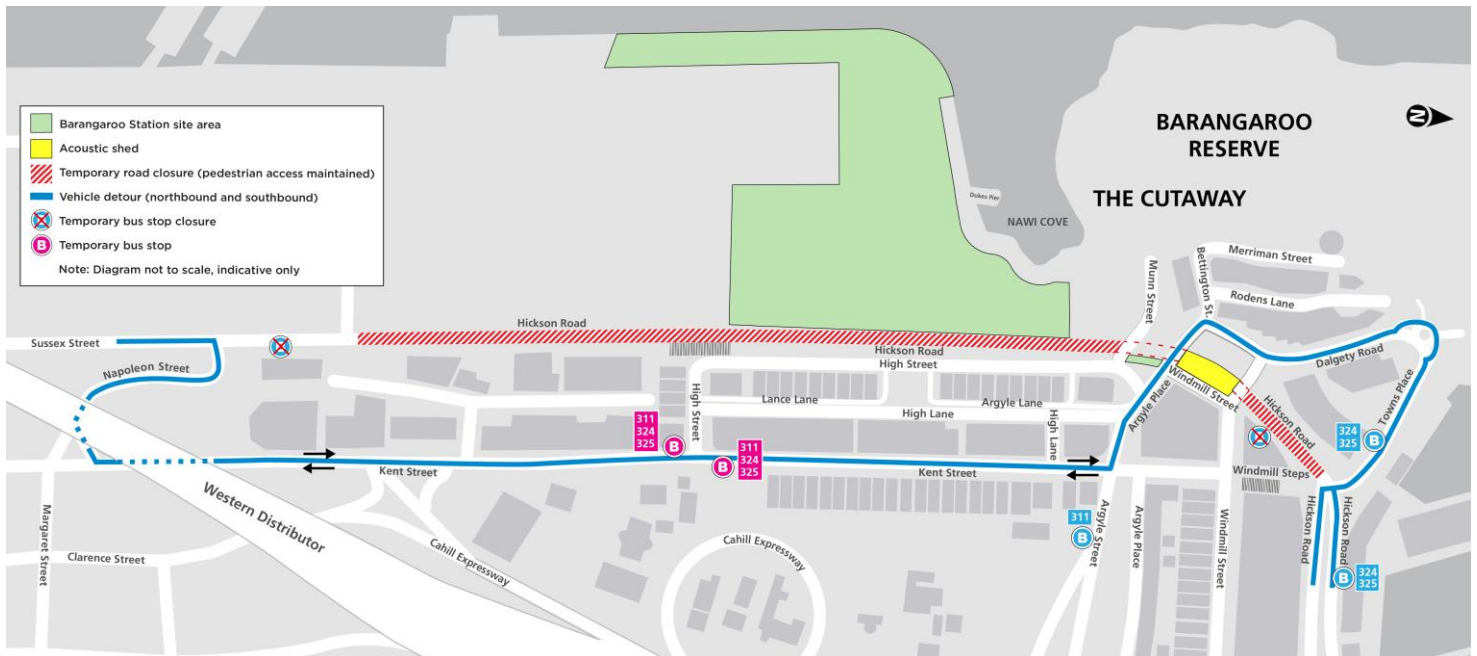
- There will be a temporary road closure on Hickson Road between Towns Place and Watermans Quay during this work. Road users may experience short delays.
- Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
- Temporary lighting may be used to ensure a safe work site and will be directed away from properties.
- There will be increased light vehicle and truck movements.
- Equipment to be used includes mobile cranes, elevated work platforms and a large remote controlled trailer
- Pedestrian access will be maintained along Hickson Road and access to the High Steps, Nawi Cove and Barangaroo Reserve will be maintained at all times.
- Access to driveways on Hickson Road will be maintained for residents and businesses.
