Sydney Metro is Australia's largest public transport project

Sydney Metro Greater West is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport.

The new railway will include stations at the airport, Western Sydney Aerotropolis and St Marys – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. World-class metro rail means better access to more places, faster travel times, less congestion on roads and a reduced reliance on cars.

Metro services have started in the city's North West between Rouse Hill and Chatswood and will be extended into the Sydney CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro West will start construction in 2020 – the project will connect Greater Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, linking communities to rail services along the way.

Site survey – St Marys

Non-intrusive survey work will be undertaken in your area to assist with early planning and design for Sydney Metro Greater West.

Work is expected to commence on **Monday 24 February 2020** and continue for up to **five weeks** (weather and site conditions permitting).

Work will include:

- Capturing details of vegetation, road surfaces, buildings and structures, and fences and embankments
- Technicians using hand held devices and tripod mounted equipment.

What to expect:

- The work is not expected to be noisy
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times.

Work will be completed during standard construction hours which are Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm.
