

Out-of-hours work update – Victoria Cross

March 2020

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66km standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5-kilometre-long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations.

Upcoming out-of-hours work – Victoria Cross south site

Due to recent poor weather, work to complete removal of the hoarding from around the perimeter of the Victoria Cross south site has been rescheduled.


This work is expected to be completed in the week beginning **Monday 16 or 23 March** site and weather conditions permitting.

Dates and time	Location	Work
Weeks beginning Monday 16 March or Monday 23 March Up to 3 nights a week (8pm-5am)	1. Miller/Berry Street	Removing the temporary hoarding that was put up to facilitate the shed removal

What to expect during out-of-hours hoarding removal

- Delivering and unloading plant and equipment.
- Temporary traffic, parking and pedestrian changes including footpath and partial lane closures (Miller and Berry Streets).
- Removing hoarding from around the site perimeter.
- Due to the nature of the works, some activities may be noisy. The project team will limit impacts wherever possible by using non-tonal reversing beepers, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, directing lights away from residences and completing noisier activities prior to midnight.
- Equipment used during this work will include but not be limited to hand tools including rattle guns, forklift, steel cutting shears, elevated work platforms, and a truck mounted crane.
- Access to buildings and driveways will always be maintained.
