

NOTIFICATION – THE BAYS / IRON COVE | 27 APRIL 2020

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

New metro rail will become the fastest, easiest and most reliable journey between the Sydney and Parramatta CBDs. Sydney Metro West will service the key precincts of Greater Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, The Bays and the Sydney CBD.

Metro services start in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro includes new underground CBD stations at Barangaroo, Martin Place and Pitt Street with new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney Metro will have 31 stations on a new 66km standalone metro rail system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history with ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Site Investigations: The Bays and Iron Cove

A new metro station has been confirmed for the Bays Precinct. A high voltage power supply will be required in the future for The Bays metro station construction site. This would be sourced from the existing Rozelle sub-transmission substation.

Essential geotechnical and utility investigation work is being undertaken by Sydney Metro West to assist with planning and design work of the future power supply. This work is required to determine the underlying rock conditions and confirm the location of underground infrastructure surrounding The Bays power station site.

Please see map overleaf to inform the work locations. This work is expected to commence on Monday 4th May 2020 for up to six weeks, weather and site conditions permitting. Work is being done during standard construction hours Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday 8am-1pm.

Work will include:

- Establishing a temporary site with site fencing
- Using a truck mounted drill rig to bore below ground level
- Removing spoil from site using a vacuum excavation truck
- Partial road closures and pedestrian changes
- Excavating trenches and recording underground infrastructure locations.

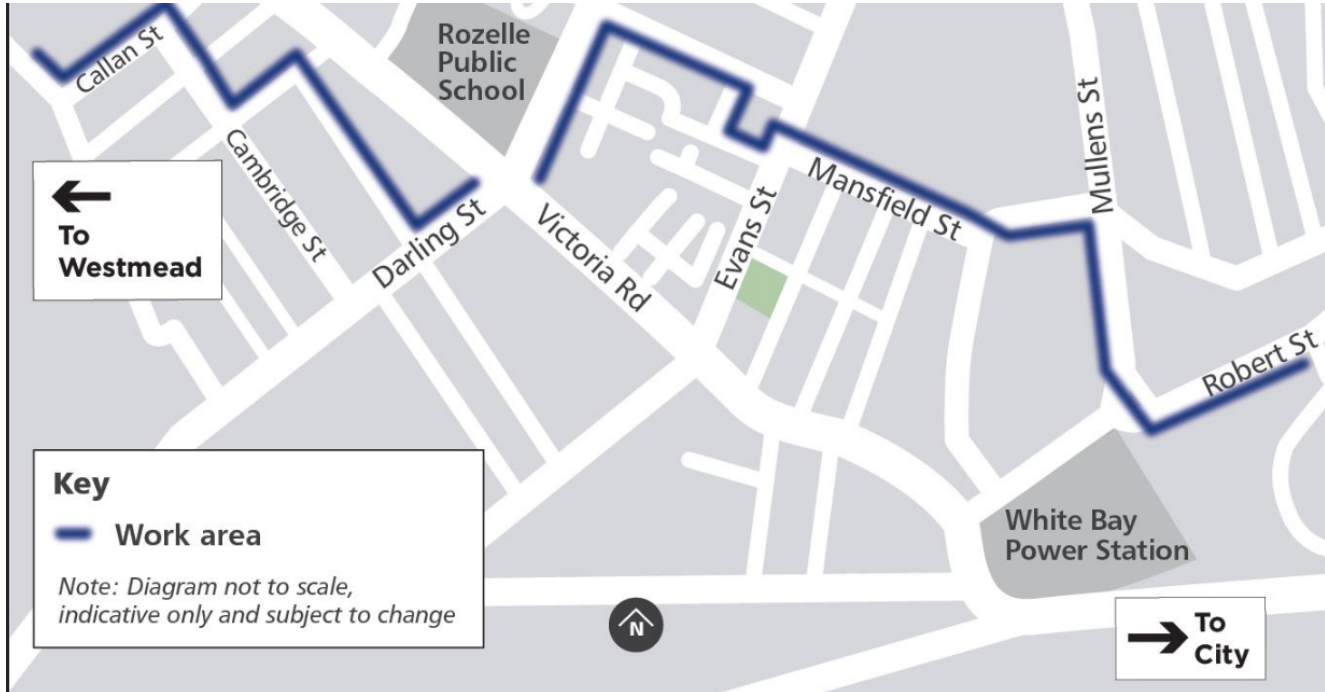
What to expect:

- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community
- Some of the activities are expected to be noisy, the team will minimise impacts where possible
- Access to pathways, buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times
- Parking may be temporarily restricted in some locations
- There will be no impact to utility services in the area
- The area will be reinstated at the completion of work.

Thank you for your cooperation while we complete these essential works.

Sydney Metro will continue to undertake work across its projects in accordance with current Government advice, and will continue to implement social distancing and travel and hygiene measures to protect employees and members of the community. Continuing with these works is critical to ensuring project continuity, and the project team will continue to review and assess activities in line with any further updates.
