

Notification – Central Station

16 March 2020

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

Oversize deliveries in Randle Lane, Surry Hills

The construction of the new entrance to Central Station at 20-28 Chalmers Street is continuing.

As part of the works, an excavator will be delivered via Randle Street to Randle Lane. This oversize delivery will occur between **Wednesday 25 March** and **Friday 27 March 2020** between **4am and 5am**.

Due to its size, this delivery is required to be outside of standard construction hours to limit disruption to traffic and to comply with oversize delivery requirements. (See [map overleaf](#).)

[POSTPONED] End of temporary partial road closure of Randle Lane, Surry Hills

The planned reopening of Randle Lane to one way traffic has been delayed due to recent weather.

Randle Lane will be reinstated from **6pm Friday 27 March 2020**. (See [map overleaf](#).)

What to expect

- Access to Randle Lane will be from Elizabeth Street only.
- Access to private car parks and emergency exits onto Randle Lane will be maintained at all times. Rubbish collection will operate as usual.
- Access through Randle Lane will be maintained at all times. Delays may be experienced at times; the team will make every effort to facilitate access in a timely manner.
- Some construction vehicle movements should be expected in and around Randle Lane.
- During standard work hours, traffic control will be located in Randle Lane to safely guide local traffic, pedestrians and other road users around the work.
- During oversize deliveries, traffic control will be located at both entrances to Randle Lane to safely guide local traffic, pedestrians and other road users around the work.
- During oversize deliveries, access to Randle Street from Randle Lane may be delayed. A lane closure on Randle Street and use of the delivery bay is required to deliver and remove large equipment.

As a reminder, work will continue **from 1pm to 5pm Saturdays in March 2020**. Sydney Metro will minimise impacts and avoid high noise activities between 1pm and 5pm wherever possible.

Standard working hours


Standard working hours are Monday to Friday, 7am–6pm and Saturday, 8am–1pm.
