

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

New metro rail will become the fastest, easiest and most reliable journey between the Sydney and Parramatta CBDs. Sydney Metro West will service the key precincts of Greater Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, The Bays and the Sydney CBD.

Metro services started in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro includes new underground CBD stations at Barangaroo, Martin Place and Pitt Street with new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney Metro will have 31 stations on a new 66km standalone metro rail system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history with ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Out-of-hours Utility Investigations: The Bays

Due to Port Authority work operations, this underground services investigation will be done outside standard construction hours between 6pm and 4am on **Friday 17 July 2020**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work will involve:

- Visual inspection for location of existing service routes
- Inspecting a number of existing service pits
- Inspecting Sydney Water culverts and access points with a portable CCTV camera
- Surveying using hand held instruments.

What to expect:

- Traffic control and signage will be in place for the safety of workers
- Noise from these activities is expected to be minimal
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.

Equipment used for our night work includes but is not limited to; a light vehicle, survey equipment, and hand held survey equipment.

Day work Utility Investigations: The Bays

Essential underground services investigation work is being undertaken by Sydney Metro West to assist with planning and design at The Bays. The services investigation will be done on **Friday 17 July 2020**, during standard construction hours 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, weather and site conditions permitting

Work will involve:

- Excavating trenches and recording underground infrastructure locations
- Removing spoil from site using a vacuum excavation truck
- Partial road closures and pedestrian changes.

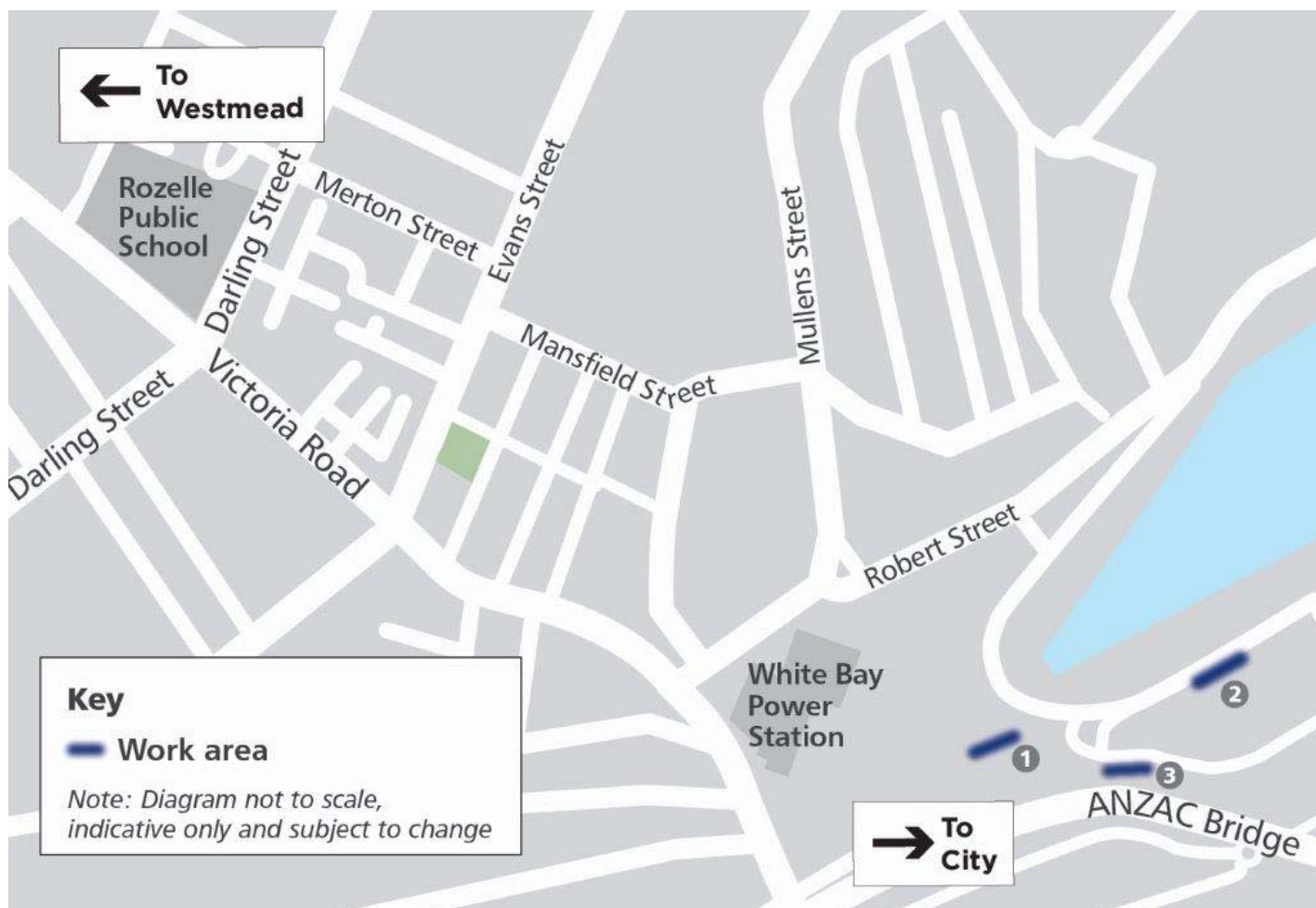
What to expect:

- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community
- Some of the activities are expected to be noisy, the team will minimise impacts where possible



- Access to pathways, buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times
- There will be no impact to utility services in the area
- The area will be reinstated at the completion of work.
