

## Notification – Barangaroo Station

11 August 2020

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5 kilometre long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations, including one at Barangaroo.

### Out-of-hours work – Hickson Road, Barangaroo

From **Tuesday 18 August 2020**, out-of-hours maintenance work will be carried out to replace a section of stormwater guttering at the Barangaroo Station site. For the safety of workers, the work will be done outside of standard construction hours between **6pm and midnight Monday to Friday**.

The guttering, which is located under the temporary Hickson Road bridge structure, is expected to take about **one week** to replace, weather and site conditions permitting.

#### Work will involve:

- Replacing steel guttering under the Hickson Road bridge structure using the tower crane, elevated work platforms and hand tools
- Tower crane operations (until 8pm).

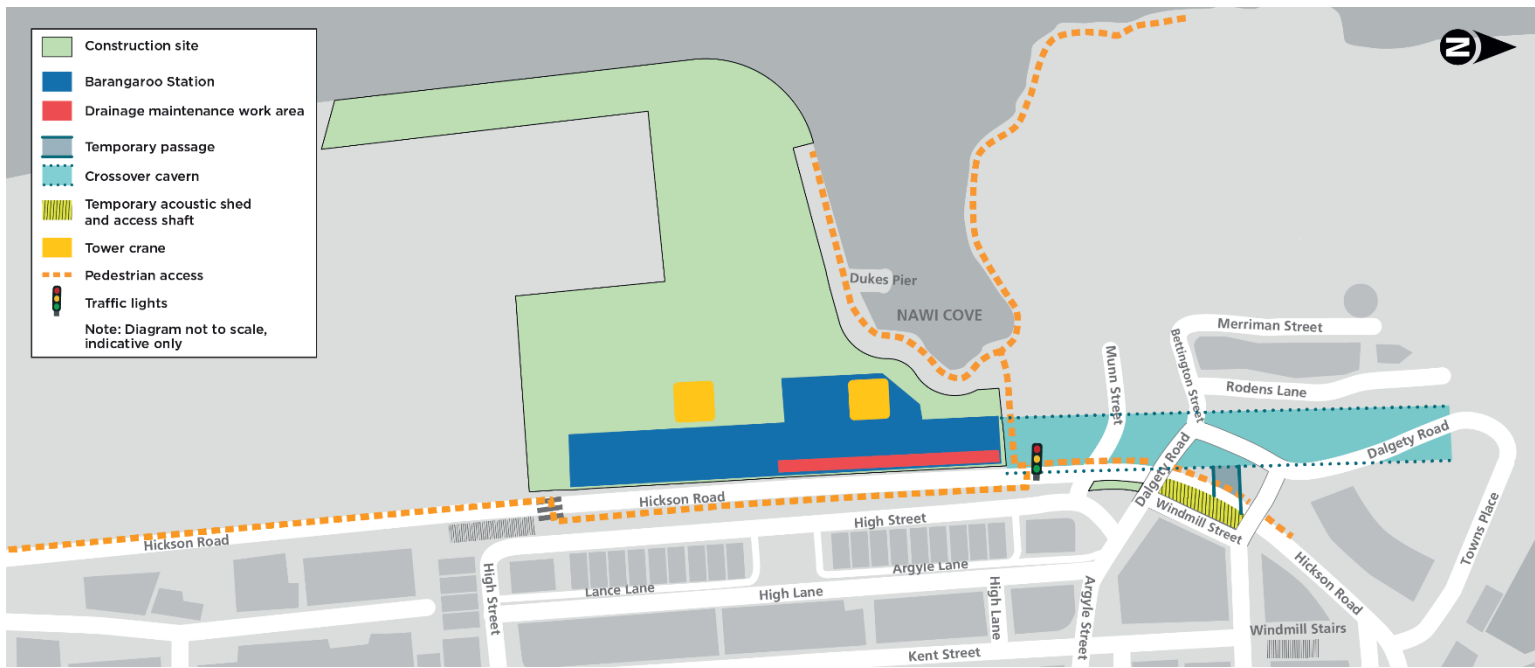

#### What to expect

- There will be intermittent periods of noisy work. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible and carry out the noisiest activities as early in the night as possible.
- Noise reduction measures will include using non-tonal reversing beepers, turning off equipment when not in use, using temporary noise blankets around noisier equipment where possible and instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum.
- There will be increased light vehicle and truck movements.
- Equipment to be used includes drills, rattle guns, tower crane (until 8pm), elevated work platforms, grinders and hand tools.
