

## **Notification – Barangaroo Station**

8 October 2020

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5 kilometre long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations, including one at Barangaroo.

### **Out-of-hours temporary power supply**

Temporary generators will be required from **2pm Thursday 15 October to 6am Friday 16 October** at the Barangaroo Station site and north of the acoustic shed on Hickson Road. This is to ensure power is maintained to the tunnels and station area during essential maintenance work. **The work will not impact residential or business electricity services.**

Where possible, noise blankets will be used to minimise impacts and the generators will be removed from the site as soon as the work is complete. One lane of Hickson Road (north of Dalgety Road) will be closed during the work, with two-way traffic maintained in the other lane under traffic control.

### **Work will involve**

- Removing site fencing and delivering temporary generators
- Electrical maintenance work
- Reinstating site fencing
- Packing up and demobilising the work site.

### **What to expect**

- There will be intermittent periods of noisy work. Any high impact noise activities will be carried out as early as possible and cease before midnight.
- Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
- Temporary lighting may be used to ensure a safe work site and will be directed away from properties.
- There will be increased light vehicle and truck movements.
- Equipment used will include drills, hand tools and temporary generators.
- There will be temporary single lane closures on Hickson Road during out-of-hours work. Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community.
- Access to the High Steps, Nawi Cove and Barangaroo Reserve will be maintained at all times.
- Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
