

Notification – Central Station

14 October 2020

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

Oversize deliveries in Randle Lane, Surry Hills

The construction of the new entrance to Central Station at 20-28 Chalmers Street is continuing and excavation will continue to reach the 16 metres depth required.

As part of the works, a 23T excavator will be delivered via Randle Street to Randle Lane. This will occur between **Wednesday 21 October** and **Friday 23 October 2020** between **4am and 5am**.

Due to the size of the crane, this delivery is required to be outside of standard construction hours to limit disruption to traffic and to comply with oversize delivery requirements. (See [map overleaf](#).)

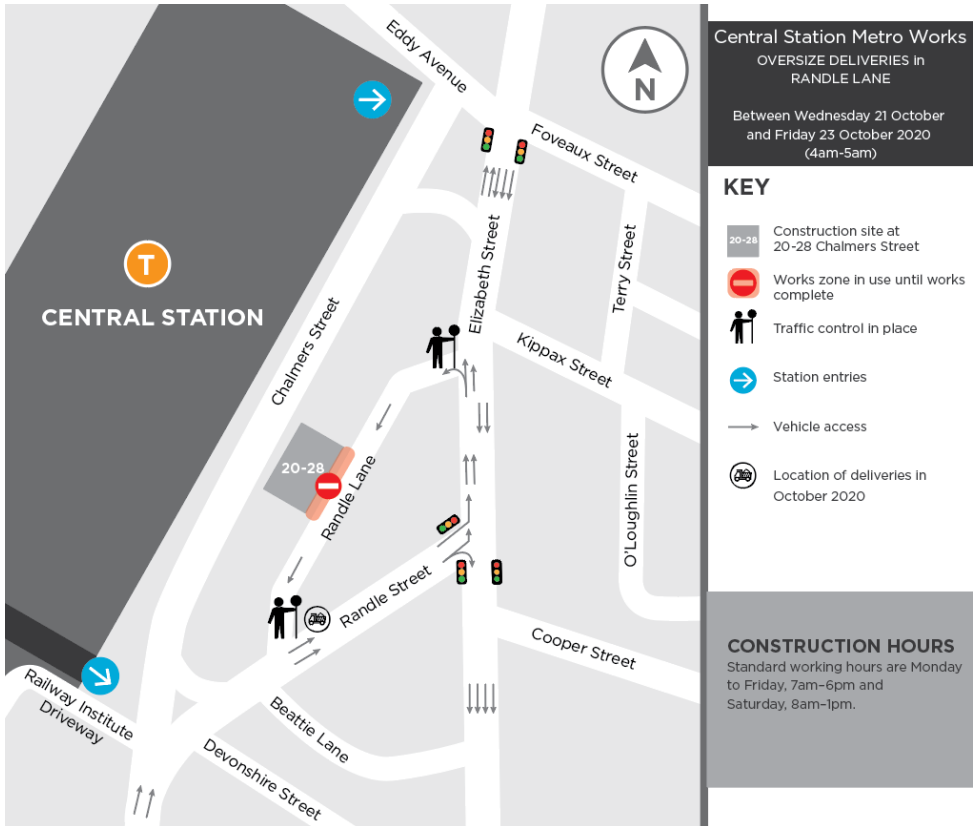
What to expect

- Access to private car parks and emergency exits onto Randle Lane will be maintained at all times. Rubbish collection will operate as usual.
- Access through Randle Lane will be maintained at all times. Delays may be experienced at times; the team will make every effort to facilitate access in a timely manner.
- Some construction vehicle movements should be expected in and around Randle Lane.
- During standard work hours, traffic control will be located in Randle Lane to safely guide local traffic, pedestrians and other road users around the work.

- During oversized deliveries, traffic control will be located at both entrances to Randle Lane to safely guide local traffic, pedestrians and other road users around the work. A lane closure on Randle Street and use of the delivery bay is required to deliver and remove large equipment.
