

Notification – Sydney International Speedway, Eastern Creek

A new world-class speedway for Western Sydney

The NSW Government is delivering a world class speedway within Western Sydney Parklands' Precinct 5: Eastern Creek Motor Sports which will be an exciting addition to the existing motorsport precinct and create a Motorplex destination for international, national and local racing events.

The new speedway would be a key contributor to the NSW economy and support tourism in Western Sydney, bringing in interstate and overseas competitors, crews and spectators.

Abergeldie has been awarded the contract to build the new Sydney International Speedway. Subject to planning approvals, construction is expected to start in December 2020. Operation of the new Sydney International Speedway is anticipated to commence in September 2021.

Site establishment: Sydney International Speedway

Early work will be undertaken to prepare the site for major construction. This work is expected to commence on **Monday 2 November and will continue until December 2020**. Work is being done during standard construction hours Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm.

This work has been assessed and determined by Sydney Metro West in accordance with the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act.

Work will involve:

- Constructing temporary car parking
- Establishing internal roads
- Constructing a southern entrance onto Ferrers Road
- Utility locating and surveys.

What to expect:

- The work will generate some noise but impact is expected to be minimal
- Traffic control and directional signage may be used for the safety of workers and the community
- Work will be undertaken within the Sydney International Speedway and Sydney Dragway sites with minor work on Ferrers Road for the construction of the the southern entrance
- Increased truck movements.

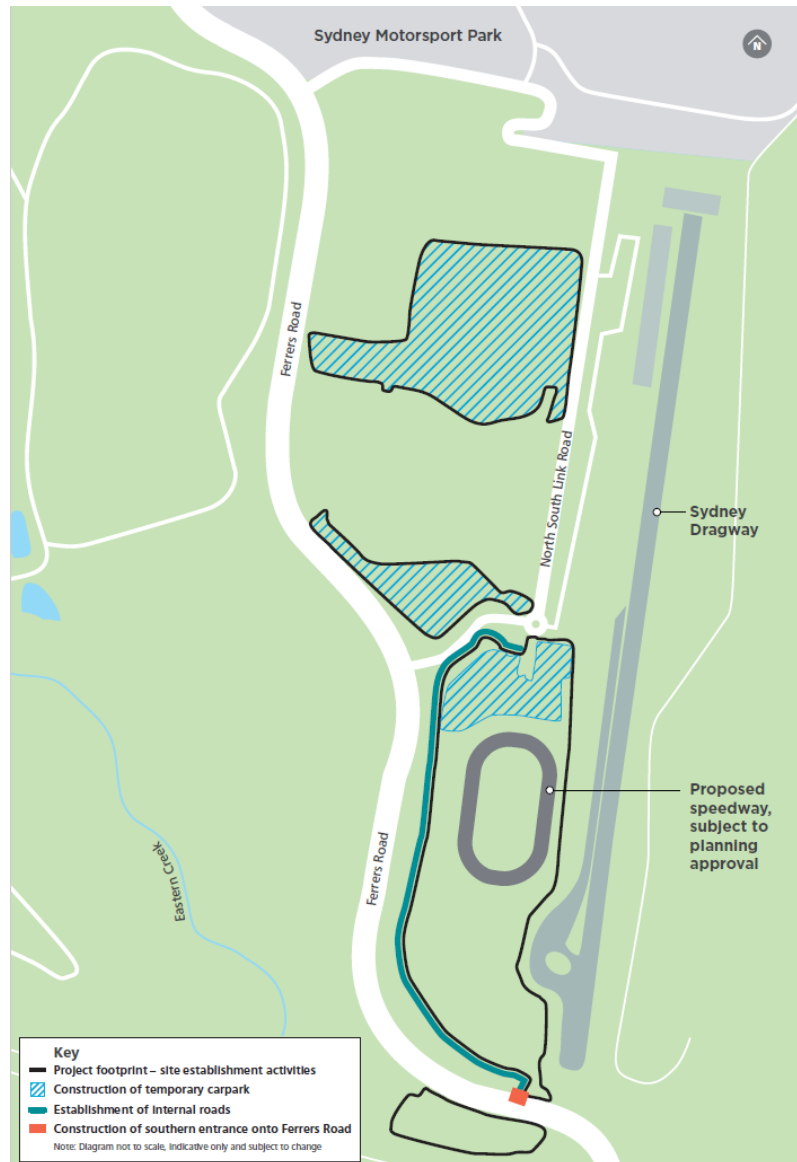
Changes to traffic:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include temporary and permanent traffic signage, traffic controllers present on the road or partial road closures. The times of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals.

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to; excavators, compactors, dump trucks, and road trucks.

Subject to planning approvals, major construction is planned to commence in December 2020 and is expected to be completed in late 2021. We will provide community and stakeholders with further updates as the project progresses.
