

Notification – Barangaroo Station

9 November 2020

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5 kilometre long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations, including one at Barangaroo.

Out-of-hours footpath work – Hickson Road

Out-of-hours work will be carried out between **6pm and 6am on Monday 16, Tuesday 17 and Wednesday 18 November 2020** near the temporary traffic lights on Hickson Road, Barangaroo, weather and site conditions permitting. Work will involve minor footpath adjustments including jack hammering, excavation and concreting activities.

This work must be done at night when there is less traffic. One lane of Hickson Road (south of Dalgety Road) will be closed during night work, with two-way traffic and pedestrian access maintained by traffic control at all times. Where possible, some work will be carried out during the day.

Work will involve

- Setting up a temporary work site, including environmental controls
- Excavation, saw cutting and jack hammering
- Pouring concrete and finishing works
- Packing up and demobilising the work site.

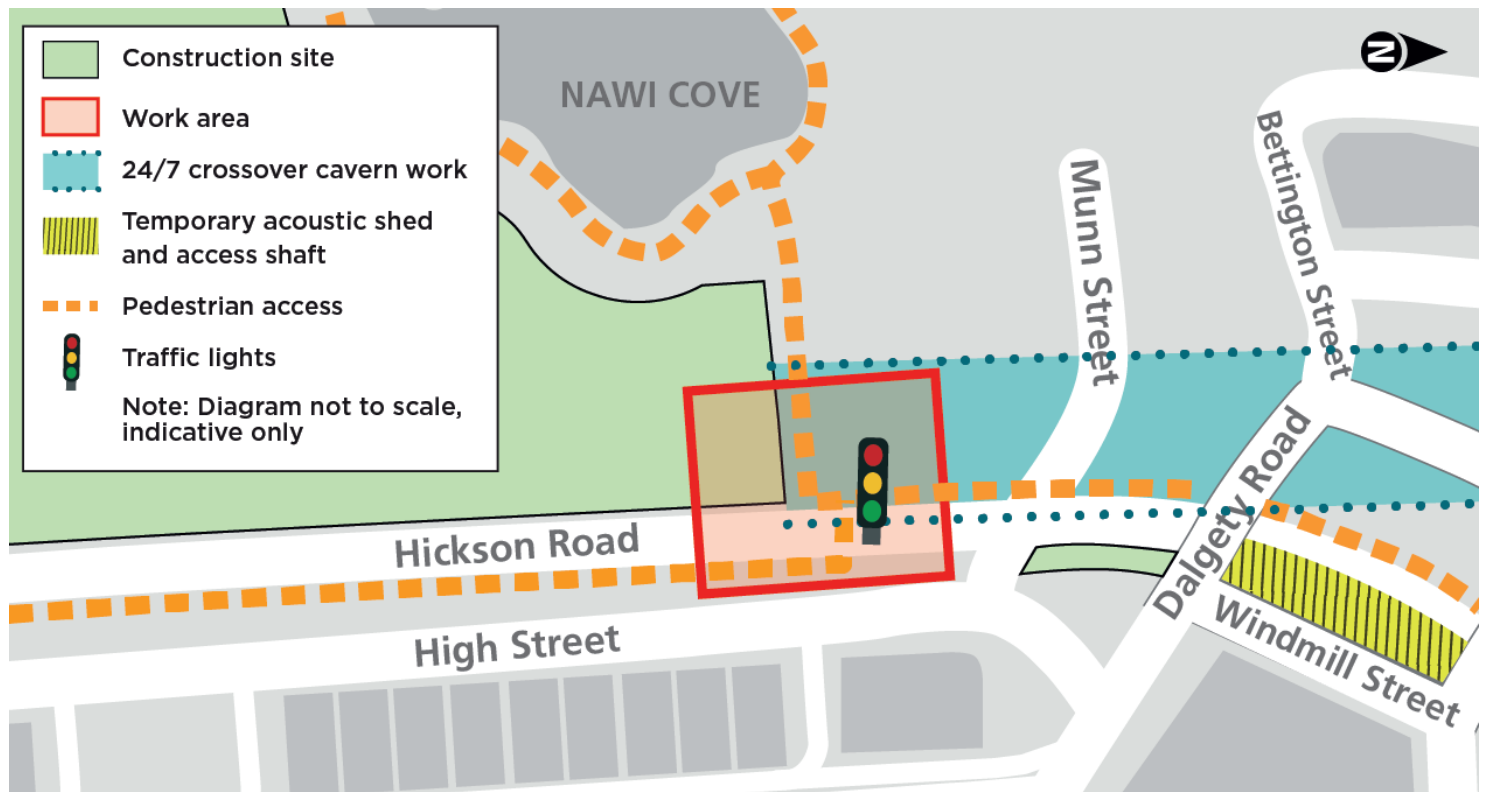
What to expect

- There will be intermittent periods of noisy work. Any high impact noise activities such as jack hammering or saw cutting will be carried out as early as possible and cease before midnight.
- Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
- Temporary lighting may be used to ensure a safe work site and will be directed away from properties.
- There will be increased light vehicle and truck movements.
- Equipment used will include excavators, saw cutters, jack hammers and hand tools.
- There will be temporary single lane closures on Hickson Road during out-of-hours work. Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community.
- Access to the High Steps, Nawi Cove and Barangaroo Reserve will be maintained at all times.
- Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
