

## Project update

November 2020

### Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5 kilometre long twin railway tunnels from Chatswood to Sydenham and excavating six new Sydney Metro stations.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, commercial building above and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

### Out of hours electrical substation and watermain works along Miller and Berry streets

As part of its works, Lendlease need to install underground conduits for the new electricity substation and also upgrade the existing watermain facilities. These works will involve the following:

- surveying existing underground services and marking these on the ground prior to the work
- establishment of small temporary work areas at each proposed trench locations
- saw cutting and removal of ground surfaces
- digging of small trenches
- installation of electrical conduits
- installation of watermain pipework
- loading and removal of excavated material
- backfill and reinstatement of road and footpath surface
- temporary parking lane and short term lane closures along Berry and Miller streets
- temporary partial pedestrian footpath closures with alternative routes provided.

#### Standard work hours

Standard work hours are Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 1pm.

#### Out of hours work

Due to high daytime traffic volumes and the need to ensure pedestrian safety, these works will need to be completed outside of standard construction work hours and are expected to take 10 weeknights to complete (weather permitting). The electrical works are scheduled to be undertaken from **Monday 23 November to Friday 18 December between 8pm and 5am**. In addition, the watermain works will need to be undertaken over the weekends to minimise traffic impacts within the area. These works are expected to occur over two consecutive weekends from **10am Friday 11 December to 5am Monday 14 December** and **10am Friday 18 December to 5am Monday 21 December**. Dates are subject to coordination with the Tunnelling and Station Excavation (TSE) contractor's ongoing works.

## What to expect


- Establishment of temporary work areas, including barriers or fencing at each trench location.
- Equipment used will include road saws, excavator, vacuum trucks, plate compactors and light vehicles.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers, pedestrians and the community.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used. Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.
