

Notification – Sydney Olympic Park

December 2020

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

New metro rail will become the fastest, easiest and most reliable journey between the Sydney and Parramatta CBDs. Sydney Metro West will service the key precincts of Greater Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, The Bays and the Sydney CBD.

Metro services started in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro includes new underground CBD stations at Barangaroo, Martin Place and Pitt Street with new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney Metro will have 31 stations on a new 66km standalone metro rail system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history with ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Utility investigations:

Essential utility investigation work is being undertaken on Figtree Drive to assist with the planning and design for Sydney Metro West. This work is required to determine the location of underground infrastructure within the future Sydney Olympic Park station site.

This work will take place on private property within the car park and driveway of 5 Figtree Drive. Work is expected to commence on Monday 4 January 2020 for up to two business days, weather and site conditions permitting. Work is being done during standard construction hours Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday 8am-1pm.

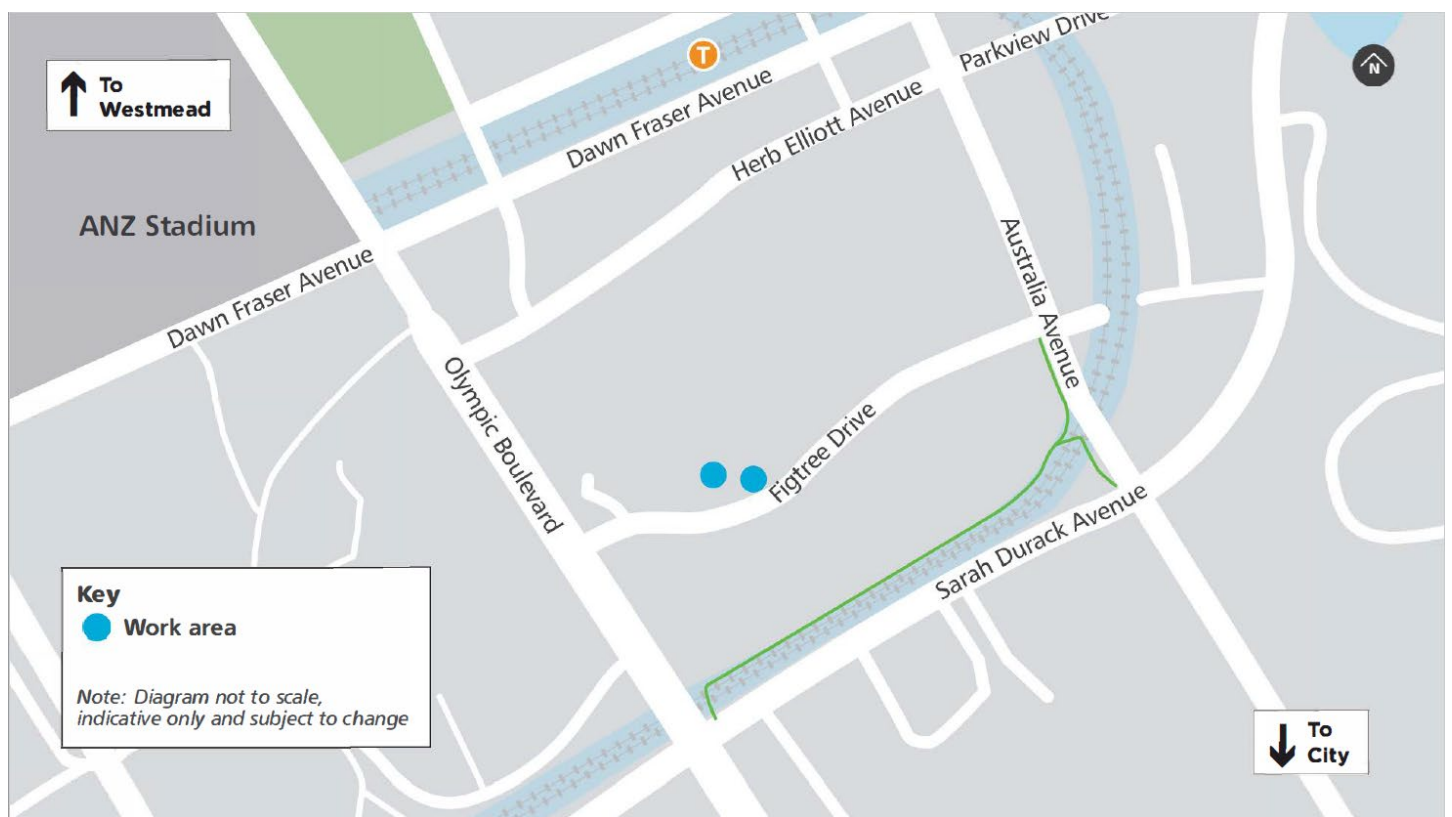
The work will involve:

- Establishing a temporary site
- Removal of concrete and asphalt with bob saw
- Removing spoil from site using a vacuum excavation truck
- Partial lane closures and pedestrian changes
- Excavating trenches and recording of underground infrastructure locations
- Reinstatement of the area.

What to expect:

- Traffic control and directional signage will be used
- Some activities are expected to be noisy, the team will minimise impacts where possible
- Access to private property will be maintained at all times
- Parking may be temporarily restricted while work takes place
- There will be no impact to the operation of utility services
- The area will be reinstated at the completion of work.
