

Pitt Street Station

January and February 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport program

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Pitt Street Station is situated within the CBD, largely surrounded by high-rise commercial and residential buildings. The station will run beneath Pitt and Castlereagh streets, and will have two entrances that connect to the platforms via pedestrian tunnels.

Weekend road closures to install tower cranes and site hoarding in the Pitt Street North site

Following the establishment of work sites for the construction of the Pitt Street Station buildings, two new tower cranes will be installed within the site compound. To facilitate the installation of the tower cranes in the North site, temporary weekend road closures and traffic changes will be required on Park Street between Pitt Street and Castlereagh Street.

Details of the Pitt Street Station North and South site locations are shown in the map overleaf.

When

- **Weekend 1: 11pm Saturday 13 February to 12am on Monday 15 February (25 hour duration)**
- **Weekend 2: 11pm Saturday 27 February to 12am on Monday 1 March (25 hour duration)**

A contingency weekend has been scheduled for both weekend road closures if they cannot take place on the above dates due to adverse weather conditions or other unforeseen events. The contingency date for **weekend 1** is **11pm Saturday 20 February to 12am on Monday 22 February** (25 hour duration). The contingency **date for weekend 2** is **11pm Saturday 6 March to 12am on Monday 8 March** (25 hour duration).

Work will involve:

- temporary vehicle and pedestrian traffic changes including lane closures and footpath diversions
- delivery of site equipment including tower cranes to the North site compound.

What to expect

- Temporary road and lane closures on Park Street between Pitt Street and Castlereagh Street including:
 - closure of three traffic lanes: both eastbound lanes and one of three westbound lanes on Park Street
 - the remaining two open lanes will facilitate one lane of traffic in each direction on Park Street.
- No right turn permitted for vehicles travelling:
 - westbound on Park Street to Pitt Street northbound
 - eastbound on Park Street to Castlereagh Street southbound.
- Bus services and local access will be permitted to make these traffic movements. Access to properties will be maintained at all times, please liaise with traffic control personnel on duty.

- The pedestrian footpath on the northern side of Park Street between Pitt Street and Castlereagh Street, adjacent to the site compound, will be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the southern footpath.
- Variable message boards (VMS) will be in place to advise road users of the changed traffic conditions.

Temporary changes to bus stops

- The westbound bus stop on Park Street between Pitt Street and Castlereagh Street (Stop ID:2000252) will be closed. Please use the nearest bus stop approx. 70m to the west (Stop ID: 2000425)
- The eastbound bus stop on Park Street between Pitt Street and Castlereagh Street (Stop ID:2000426) will be closed. Please use the nearest bus stop approx. 70m to the west (Stop ID: 2000249)

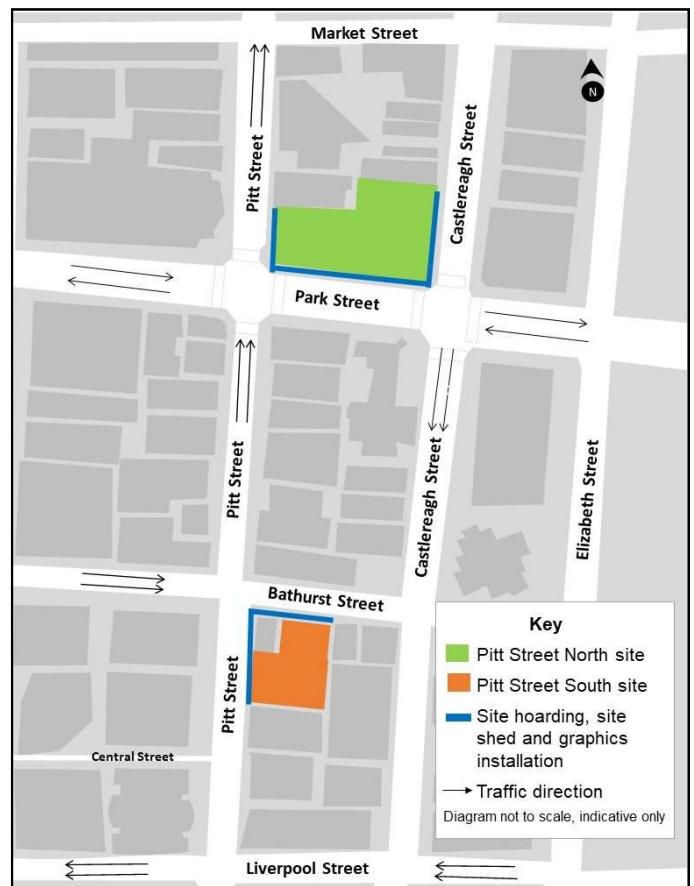
Other out-of-hours work from Wednesday 27 January to Sunday 28 February

Work will also take place to deliver and install site sheds, site hoarding, graphics and signage on the site hoarding at the Pitt Street North and South sites. This work is expected to take up to **18 night shifts** on the North site and up to **17 night shifts** on the South site to complete (weather permitting) from **Wednesday 27 January to Sunday 28 February** between **9pm to 5am**. The location of the construction sites is shown on the map below.
