

Project update

February 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, commercial building above and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

Upcoming work – Victoria Cross Station sites

Below is an indicative table of activities scheduled at the two Victoria Cross Station sites in February.

Victoria Cross Station South site	<p>Work may include but is not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> installing hoardings and site accommodation surrounding the project site bordering Miller and Berry streets mobilising equipment and continuing work zone establishment along Miller Street while maintaining pedestrian access at all times detailed excavation and piling works for tower crane bases on Miller Street.
Victoria Cross Station North site	<p>The following works will be conducted within the project site to include but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> delivery and installation of scaffolding, internal hoardings, pavement and accommodation sheds modifying site shed and installing temporary services <ul style="list-style-type: none"> relocating the existing power supply by moving the electrical kiosk on the corner of Miller Street and McLaren Street into the project site mobile crane set up to hoist material and equipment into the project site construction of tower crane using piling equipment and excavators for crane footings.

Monday 1 February to Thursday 11 February Up to 8 nights Monday – Thursday 8pm to 6am	Miller and Berry streets	Hoarding and site accommodation installation work: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • delivery of equipment surrounding project site • installation and connection of hoarding • delivery and installation of site accommodation containers • light vehicles and hand held drills.
Wednesday 17 February 6pm to 6am	Miller and Berry streets	Mobile crane for machinery mobilisation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • delivery of excavators and equipment into the project site via mobile cranes.
Friday 19 February 6pm to Sunday 21 February 12am Friday 26 February 6pm to Sunday 28 February 12am * * contingency date if required	Miller Street	Tower crane delivery and installation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • delivery and installation of tower crane • Miller Street southbound lane closure.

Standard work hours


Standard work hours are Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 1pm.

What to expect

- Temporary pedestrian control gates and a traffic controller on Spring Street to assist for truck movements into the South site.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts where possible. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used. Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.
