

Project update – Marrickville dive site

February - March 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66-kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5 kilometre-long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations. Systems Connect (a joint venture between CPB contractors and UGL Limited) is delivering line-wide work to turn the excavated tunnels into a working railway between Chatswood and Sydenham.

Upcoming work at Marrickville dive site and stabling yard

Work at the Marrickville dive site and stabling yard will be consistent over the next two months. Utilities work is continuing along Edinburgh Road/Railway Parade and will include some out-of-hours activities. In the stabling yard, work to upgrade the stormwater drainage system, including earthworks to raise the level of the site, is ongoing. Systems Connect is continuing installing rail tracks and other infrastructure at the dive site. See the table below for more details.

Marrickville stabling yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Excavating and constructing the drainage network involving concrete work and installing prefabricated concrete segments • Removing redundant structures including the spoil shed and water treatment plant • Excavating and removing concrete floors by hammering and then backfilling • Removing excavated material from the site • Completing construction of retaining walls and raising the level of sections of the site • Installing topsoil and grass as required • Delivering plant and materials
Marrickville dive site (Systems Connect activities)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Commissioning a gantry crane inside gantry shed, setting up satellite office/site amenities • Delivering materials and plant, using the dive site to access the tunnels • Working inside the tunnels, including fit out activity using trackform machines (work trains) • Installing rail and track slab construction • Erecting the double-storey workforce site facility

Edinburgh Road and surrounding streets including Railway Parade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Installing new stormwater culverts on Railway Parade • Concreting work on Murray Street and Edinburgh Road • Changes to utilities and road alignment, roundabouts and parking

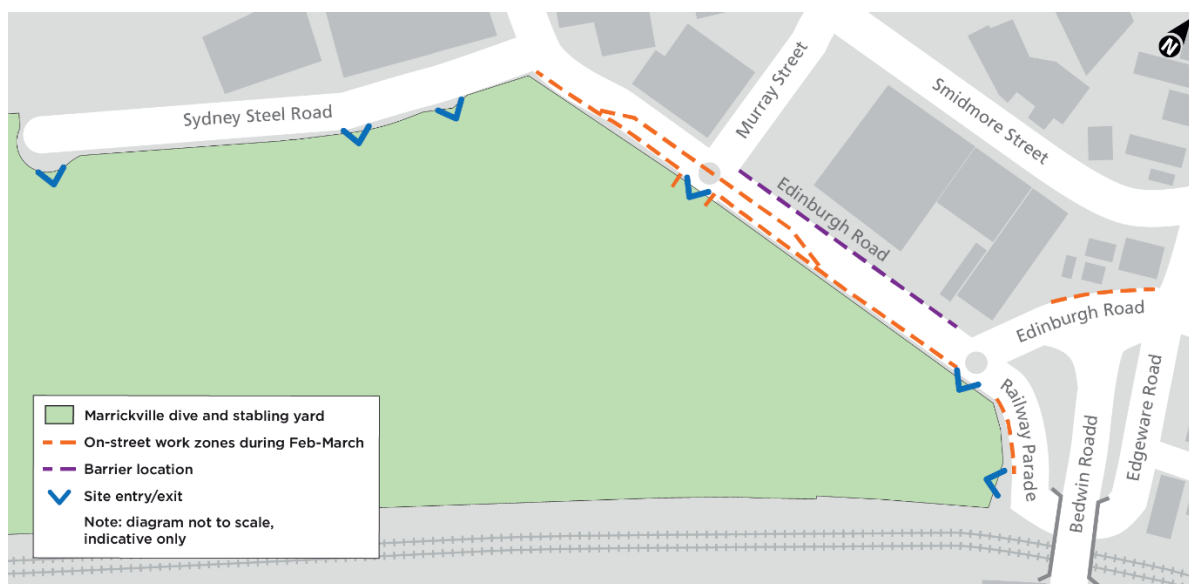
Marrickville stabling yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Some work within the site including crane lifts, excavation, form work and concrete work • Deliveries of plant and materials, including spoil, seven days a week from 5.30am
Marrickville dive site	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deliveries of plant and materials for work in the tunnels • Electrical fit out of tunnel cross passages • Construction of trackform slabs inside the tunnel and portals

Reminder: Notifications are emailed to registered stakeholders and can also be downloaded from the project website via sydnymetro.info. Emails provide updated information on dates, locations and details of activities including out-of-hours activities. What to expect

- Utility investigations and installations will mostly occur during construction hours, but some essential activities may involve out-of-hours works. All high noise work including jackhammering will be undertaken prior to midnight.
- Equipment used will include excavators, cranes, forklift, vacuum trucks, tippers, heavy vehicles, chipper, road sweeper, saws, jack hammers, roller, line marker, auger bore, concrete trucks, asphalt pavers, and pumps.
- Extended concrete pours, finishing and cleaning work may be required outside standard construction hours on occasion, involving concrete trucks and pumps, high pressure hoses, a small crane and excavators.
- Truck movements and deliveries to and from the site may occur outside standard construction hours. Periodic traffic and pedestrian changes will be required including lane and footpath closures. Traffic control and signage will be placed according to the work location and public safety requirements.
- All out-of-hours work is subject to site and weather conditions and may be rescheduled without notice.
