



# Project update

February 2021

## Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, commercial building above and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

## Tower crane delivery and installation at Victoria Cross North site

A tower crane will be delivered and installed at the Victoria Cross North site between **7am Friday 26 February and 6pm Sunday 28 February**.

If work is unable to be completed on this date due to adverse weather, the installation will continue the following weekend from Friday 5 March to Sunday 7 March.

### Standard work hours

Standard work hours are Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 1pm.

### Weekend and public holiday work at the Victoria Cross metro sites

The NSW Government has approved construction sites to work extended hours across weekends 7am to 6pm and public holidays throughout the COVID-19 pandemic until March 2021. The extended work hours enable the construction industry to practice appropriate social distancing with fewer workers on site on any given day by allowing work to be spread across more days in the week.

### Work will involve:

- delivery and installation of tower crane using a mobile crane from within the McLaren Street compound.

### What to expect

- Mobilisation and use of mobile cranes and heavy vehicles.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used, and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
- Traffic control and pedestrian signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community.
