

Notification – Clyde

10 March 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

New metro rail will become the fastest, easiest and most reliable journey between the Sydney and Parramatta CBDs. Sydney Metro West will service the key precincts of Greater Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, The Bays and the Sydney CBD.

Metro services started in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro includes new underground CBD stations at Barangaroo, Martin Place and Pitt Street with new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney Metro will have 31 stations on a new 66km standalone metro rail system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history with ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Site surveys: Clyde (standard construction hours and out-of-hours work)

Survey work will be undertaken in the Clyde area to assist with early planning and design work for Sydney Metro West.

Survey work will commence on **17 March 2021 for up to four weeks**, weather and site conditions permitting. Work is being done during standard construction hours Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday 8am-1pm.

Out-of-hours work

Some survey work will be completed during out-of-hours due to traffic volumes on James Ruse Drive. This work will take place the week starting **28 March 2021 for up to two weeks**, weather and site conditions permitting. Work is being done during out-of-hours Monday to Friday 10pm-5am. Please see map overleaf for work locations.

Work will involve:

- Tracing of underground services and surveying to locate existing utilities
- Survey of existing site conditions using radar ground penetrating survey equipment

What to expect:

- This work is not expected to be noisy
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times
- There will be no disruption to the delivery of utility services
- Traffic management will be in place

Equipment used:

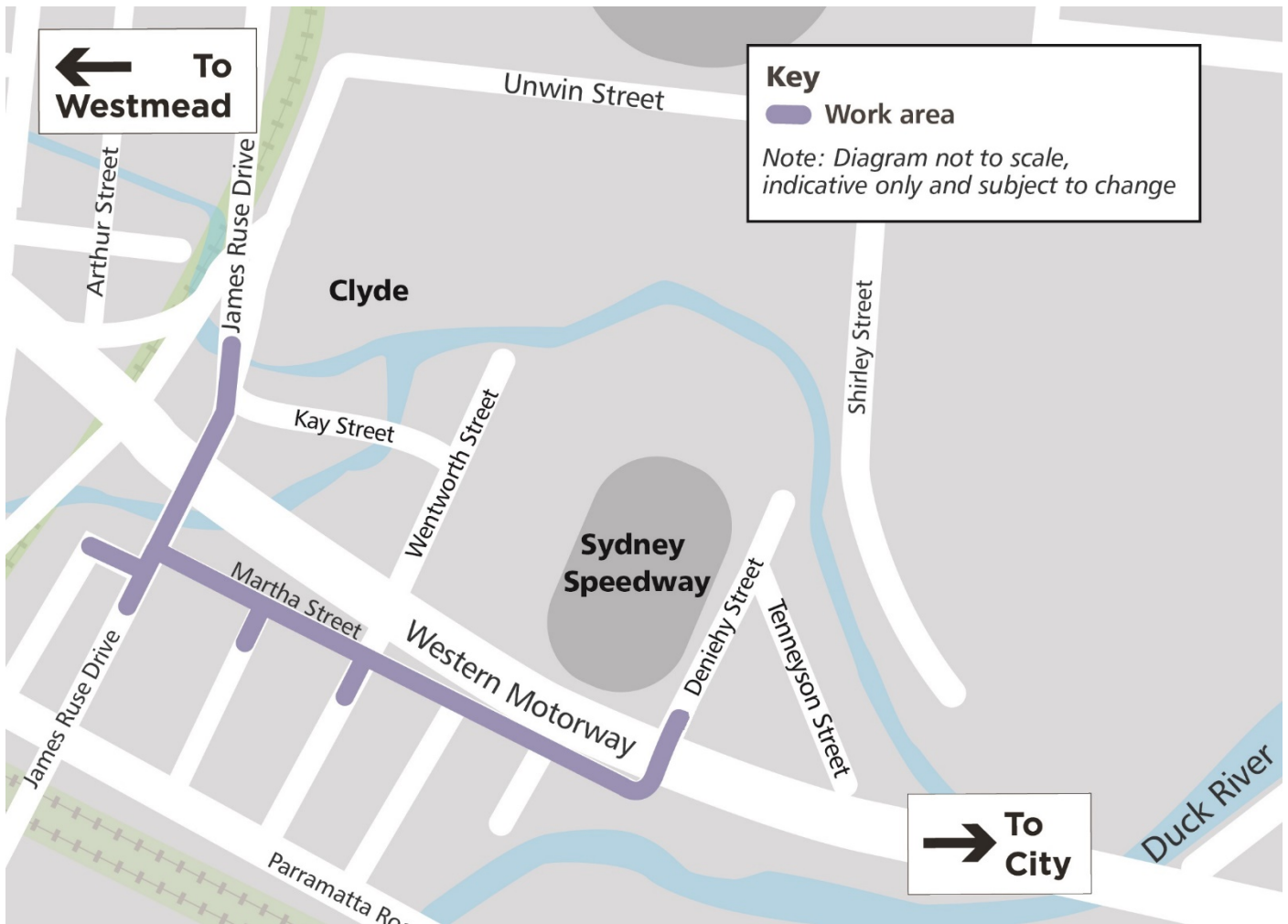
Equipment used for day and night work includes but is not limited to; survey equipment, electromagnetic wands, ground penetrating radar, temporary fencing and light vehicles.

Changes to traffic pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to

traffic conditions. This may include contraflow traffic flow, stop-slow traffic controls, or partial road closures. The times of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals.
