

Notification Update – Eastern Creek

1 April 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro West would connect Greater Parramatta with the Sydney CBD and involve the construction of around 24 kilometres of twin tunnels. Confirmed stations include Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays and Sydney CBD. This infrastructure investment would double the rail capacity of the Greater Parramatta to Sydney CBD corridor with a travel time target between the two centres of about 20 minutes.

Site establishment and early works

Sydney Metro plans to construct two adjacent precast facilities on an approximately 17 hectare site at Lenore Drive, Eastern Creek to support the delivery of the Sydney Metro West project. The site would be used to manufacture concrete segments needed to line the twin tunnels for Sydney Metro West. This proposal was exhibited for public comment in late 2020 and was determined approved on 16 March 2021.

In preparation for the precast facility, Transport for NSW (TfNSW) (on behalf of Sydney Metro), has commenced early works which will include constructing a temporary access road off the Lenore Drive/proposed Archbold Road intersection. This work has been assessed and determined by TfNSW in accordance with the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act.

This early work will prepare the site for the construction of the precast facilities' and roadworks. This early work commenced on **Monday 18 January and due to site conditions will continue until 19 April 2021**. The work will be completed during standard construction hours, Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm. Please see map overleaf for the work areas.

Night work:

Due to traffic volumes on Lenore Drive, there may be work completed during out-of-hours Sunday to Friday, 8pm until 5am (weather and site conditions permitting). The community will be notified when out of hours work is expected to occur.

Work will involve:

- Establishing a temporary site with site fencing
- Construction of a temporary access road at the intersection of Lenore Drive to Archbold Road

What to expect:

- Access will be maintained at all times
- The work will generate noise and the team will minimise impacts where possible
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community where required
- No anticipated disruption to utility services. Notification prior to any disruptions will be provided.

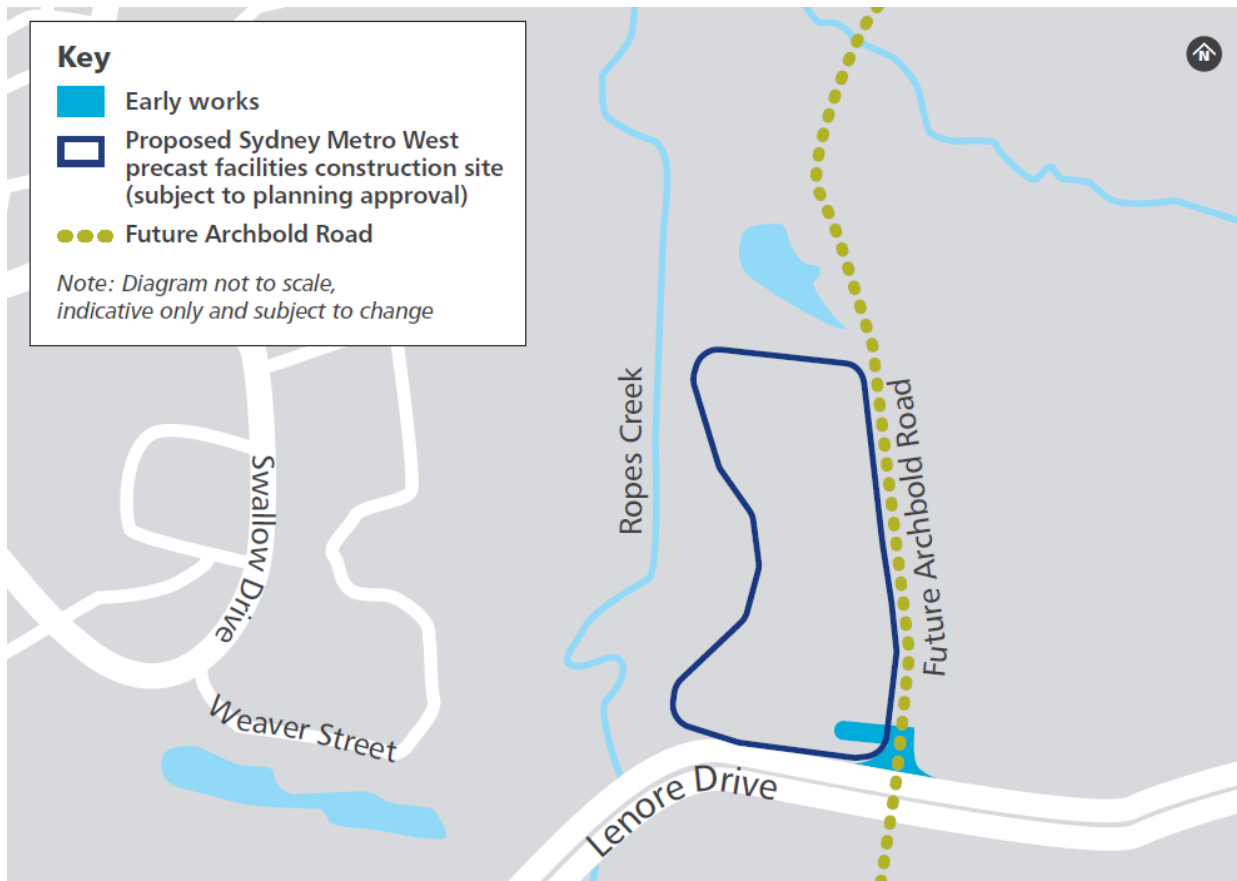
Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: excavators, compactors, dump trucks, road trucks, compaction equipment, jack hammer, saw cutters, traffic control, temporary fencing, heavy and light vehicles and generators.

Changes to traffic pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include temporary and permanent traffic signage, installation of concrete barriers, reduction in the speed limit, one lane closure and traffic controllers present on the road. The times of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals.
