

Notification Update – Clyde

1 April 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

New metro rail will become the fastest, easiest and most reliable journey between the Sydney and Parramatta CBDs. Sydney Metro West will service the key precincts of Greater Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, The Bays and the Sydney CBD.

Metro services started in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro includes new underground CBD stations at Barangaroo, Martin Place and Pitt Street with new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney Metro will have 31 stations on a new 66km standalone metro rail system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history with ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Underground services investigations: Clyde (Out-of-Hours)

Essential underground services investigation work is being undertaken in your area to assist with early planning and design for Sydney Metro West. Due to traffic volumes on James Ruse Drive this will be work completed during out-of-hours Wednesday to Monday, 10pm until 5am (weather and site conditions permitting).

This work will commence on **Monday 12 April** for up to a week, weather and site conditions permitting. Please see map overleaf for the work locations.

Work will involve:

- Visual inspection for location of existing service routes
- Inspecting a number of existing service pits
- Jetting to clean any blockage prior to CCTV
- Removal of any rubbish using the vacuum truck
- Inspecting Sydney Water culverts and access points with a portable CCTV camera
- Surveying using hand held instruments.

What to expect:

- Traffic control and signage will be in place for the safety of workers and community
- Noise from these activities is expected to be minimal
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.

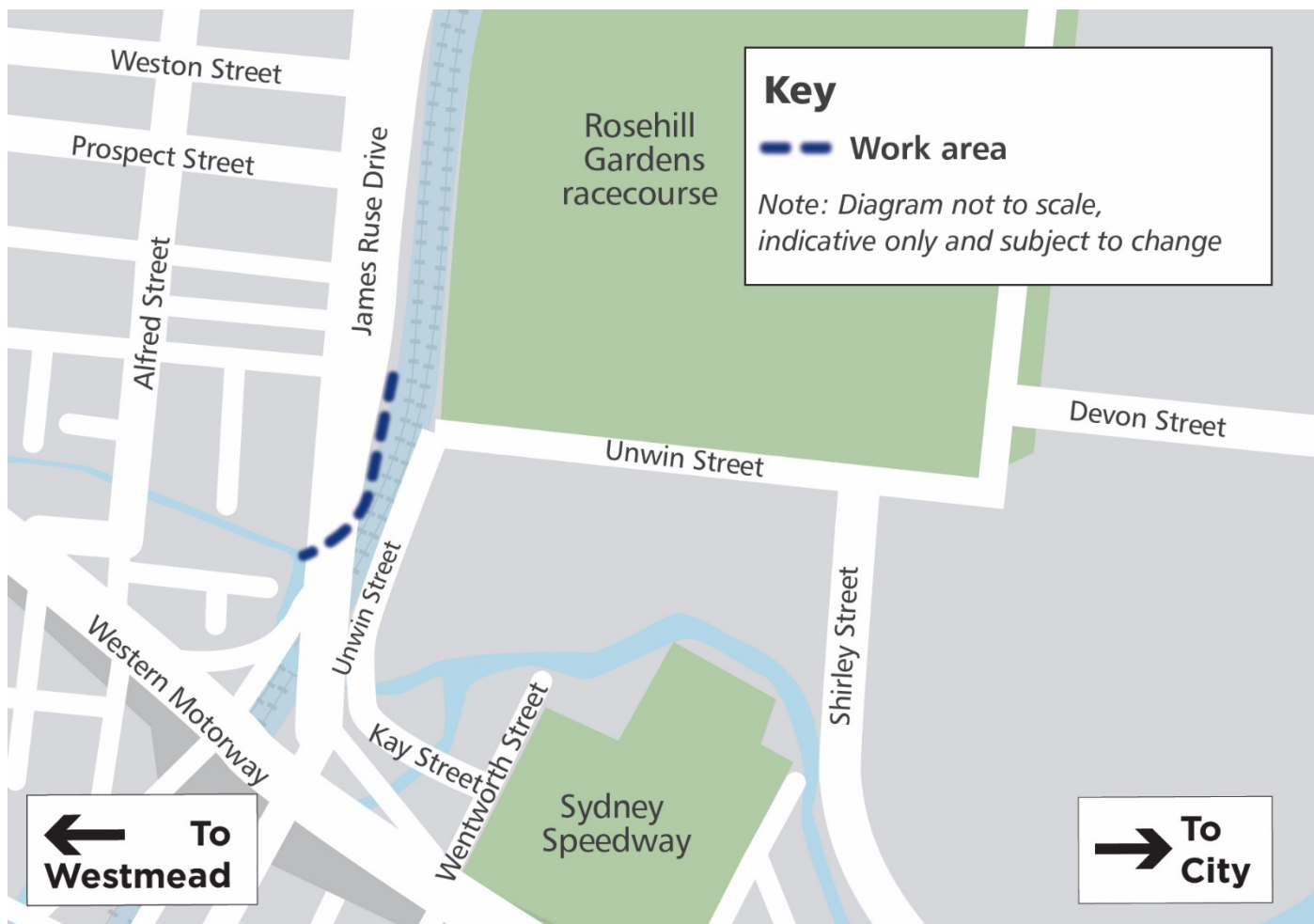
Equipment used:

Equipment to be used for this work includes but is not limited to; a light vehicle, survey equipment, vacuum truck and hand held survey equipment.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow traffic flow, stop-slow traffic controls, or partial road closures. The times of these change will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals.
