

Notification – Barangaroo Station

8 April 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66-kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5-kilometre long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations, including one at Barangaroo.

Pedestrian changes and out-of-hours concrete finishing work – Hickson Road

Hickson Road will be closed to pedestrians from 13 April 2021 between High Steps and beneath Munn Street. This is to allow concrete finishing work to continue in the Barangaroo Station box. Pedestrians will be redirected around the construction site. The available detour routes will be via the Barangaroo foreshore walk or via High Street. A map showing the detour routes is provided overleaf. Traffic controllers will be in place to temporarily guide pedestrians as these changes take effect.

Out-of-hours work

To minimise disruption to the local traffic network and ensure pedestrian safety, some work related to the concreting activities will need to be completed outside of standard construction work hours. Two-way traffic will be maintained on Hickson Road during peak hours. There will be temporary single lane closures on Hickson Road outside of peak hours to facilitate this work.

Work will involve:

- Establishing and demobilising temporary work areas
- Implementing safety and environmental controls
- Delivering plant, materials and equipment to work areas
- Installing pedestrian barriers and fencing
- Installing site signage
- Intermittent concreting activities along Hickson Road.


What to expect

- There will be temporary single lane closures on Hickson Road during this work. Two-way traffic will be maintained during peak hours and traffic controllers and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community.
- There will be intermittent periods of noisy work. The project team will limit the impact of noise wherever possible. Noise reduction measures may include using non-tonal reversing beepers, turning off equipment when not in use, completing noisier activities by midnight and instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum.
- There will be increased light vehicle and truck movements.
- Access to High Steps, Nawi Cove and Barangaroo Reserve will be maintained at all times.
- Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
- Permanent restoration of roads and footpaths affected by the work will be done at the end of the project.
