



Notification – Iron Cove/Rozelle and The Bays 3 May 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

New metro rail will become the fastest, easiest and most reliable journey between the Sydney and Parramatta CBDs. Sydney Metro West will service the key precincts of Greater Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, The Bays and the Sydney CBD.

Metro services started in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro includes new underground CBD stations at Barangaroo, Martin Place and Pitt Street with new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney Metro will have 31 stations on a new 66km standalone metro rail system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history with ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Site investigations

Sydney Metro will undertake additional investigations to assist with the planning and design of the future power supply route from the Rozelle sub-transmission substation to the future The Bays metro station. The power supply route will provide a dedicated power source to the Tunnel Boring Machines. (TBMs) which will be launched from this site. Quickway has been awarded the contract to undertake these works for Sydney Metro West.

This investigation work will be undertaken along the future power supply route from Sunday 9 May until Thursday 3 June, weather and site conditions permitting. The work is expected to take approximately one day at each location. See map overleaf for power supply route and work areas.

Where possible, work will be undertaken during standard construction hours Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday 8am-1pm.

Out-of-hours works

Due to requirements from local road authorities and to reduce the impact to local traffic, some work is required to be undertaken outside of standard construction hours. See below table for current program. (Subject to change - site and weather conditions permitting).

Residents and businesses impacted by out-of-hours work will be contacted directly.





Work will involve:

- Saw cutting and removal of road surface material
- Removing spoil from site using a vacuum excavation truck and excavators
- Excavating trenches and confirming underground conditions
- Backfilling and reinstatement at the end of work.

What to expect:

- Pedestrian access to buildings will be maintained at all times
- In the event that driveway access is impacted, directly affected stakeholders will be contacted
- Parking will be required to be removed in periodic sections to permit works and traffic control
- Noise impacts will be minimised wherever possible.

Equipment used:

Equipment used for both day and night work includes but is not limited to; excavators, road-saws, vacuum trucks, hand tools, temporary fencing, light vehicles, rollers and generators.

Changes to pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, changes to traffic conditions for pedestrians, cyclists, parking and motorists will be required and may include stop-slow traffic controls, or temporary full road closures (less than 48 hours). The times of these changes will vary and is dependent on road authority approvals. Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.
