

Project update – Artarmon

June 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central Station.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66km standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Systems Connect (an unincorporated joint venture between CPB Contractors and UGL Limited) is delivering line-wide Work, which includes installing metro rail track, power systems and infrastructure to turn the excavated tunnels into a working railway between Chatswood and Sydenham.

Extended weekend working hours in Artarmon

This notification provides an update to the June notification we recently sent you. From **Saturday 19 June 2021** until **Sunday 27 March 2022**, our weekend working hours for the substation and bulk power supply work in Artarmon will be:

- **Saturdays from 7am to 6pm**
- **Sundays from 7am to 6pm.**

If needed, the extended hours will be used to carry out low impact noise activities such as:

- importing material, plant and equipment
- general fill and structural placement (e.g. concrete pours)
- construction works for modular and substation buildings
- service investigation, excavation and installation (trenching in loose ground, no rock breaking)
- testing and commissioning.

There will be no rock hammering, piling or similarly very noisy activities during the extended hours. Please note that these activities will continue to be carried out during standard construction hours, on Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

The extended hours are possible under the Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Workdays) Order 2020 and will enable us to complete the work as soon as possible. We will endeavour not to work on Sundays where possible.

We will continue with our strong commitment to safety and take all steps to minimise noise and construction disturbance by:

- workers communicating through radio
- reversing alarms to be non-tonal only
- equipment to be switched off when not in use.

Sydney Metro will continue to undertake work across its projects in accordance with current Government advice, and will continue to implement physical distancing and travel and hygiene measures to protect employees and members of the community.
