

Project update

September 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, commercial building above and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

Upcoming work – Victoria Cross Station sites

Below is an indicative table of activities scheduled at the two Victoria Cross Station sites in September.

Location	Work in September
Victoria Cross Station North site	<p>The following works will be conducted within the project site and may include but not be limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • deliveries and concrete pouring via concrete pumps within project work zones • tower crane and hoist operations • deliveries, tower crane operations and installation of precast concrete, structural steel and formwork.
Victoria Cross Station South site	<p>Work may include but is not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • detailed excavation works including saw cutting rock and jackhammering • formwork and steel fixing works • delivery and installation of hoardings and site accommodation surrounding the project site bordering Miller Street • installing scaffolding within the site to create safe access for onsite workers • waterproofing works within site • tower crane and hoist operations • deliveries and concrete pouring via concrete pumps within project work zones.
Denison Street Stormwater works	<p>Stormwater upgrade works will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • excavation, saw cutting, hammering and hand tools • small vehicles and deliveries • installation of stormwater pipes in Denison Street.

What to expect

- Equipment used will include concrete pumps, elevated working platforms, mobile cranes, tower cranes, trucks, handheld drills and light vehicles.
- Traffic and pedestrian changes to Denison Street and surrounding streets.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers, pedestrians and the community.
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts where possible. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used. Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.

Upcoming out-of-hours work – Victoria Cross Station

Monday to Thursday nights 1 September to 30 September, up to four nights a week, 7pm to 5am	Miller Street	Hoarding and site accommodation installation and fit out: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • partial lane closure on Miller Street • Miller street footpath/pedestrian closures • delivery of equipment surrounding project site • installation and connection of hoarding • delivery and installation of site accommodation containers • mobile cranes, elevated working platforms, truck cranes, light vehicles and hand-held tools.
Monday to Friday mornings 1 September to 30 September, up to three mornings a week, 4am to 7am	South site	Delivery of the station jump form, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • partial lane closure on Miller Street • Miller Street footpath/pedestrian closures.
Monday to Friday nights 1 September to 30 September, up to five nights a week, 6pm to 5am	South site	Waterproofing and structure works: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • installation of waterproofing membrane using elevated working platforms • formwork installation works • steel fixing • mobile cranes, tower cranes, lighting towers, hoist operation and hand-held tools • concrete placing and finishing.
Monday to Sunday nights 1 September to 30 September, 6pm to 7am	Station cavern	Station cavern internal fit out and installation of services works: operation of elevated working platforms, light vehicles and hand-held tools.

Extended work hours: As previously notified, Lendlease will be implementing the following extended working hours at both Victoria Cross sites until 31 March 2022 from **7am to 6pm on Saturdays and Sundays**. During the extended hours on **Saturday 7am to 8am and 1pm to 6pm**, and **Sunday 7am to 6pm** there will be no high noise activities such as rock breaking, rock hammering, sheet piling and pile driving will occur.
