

Notification – North Strathfield

15 September 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Utility and topographical surveys: North Strathfield

Non-intrusive surveys are being undertaken to assist with the early planning and design of Sydney Metro West. This work is to locate existing services and infrastructure around North Strathfield station and will be undertaken from **Wednesday 22 September, 2021 for up to six weeks**, weather and site conditions permitting. The work will be undertaken during **standard construction hours Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm**, weather and site conditions and COVID restrictions permitting. See map overleaf for the location of these works.

In line with Public Health Orders, work is now permitted at construction sites in Greater Sydney subject to conditions. Essential site investigations will be undertaken at North Strathfield in line with current restrictions.

Work will include:

- Survey of streets near the station to verify existing services and infrastructure
- Traffic management at work locations where required
- Reinstating the area at completion of the work

What to expect:

- Noise from these activities is expected to be minimal
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- Parking may be temporarily restricted in some locations
- There will be no disruption to the delivery of utility services

Equipment used:

Equipment used for work includes but is not limited to, survey equipment, traffic management equipment, and light vehicles.
