SYDNEY METRO NORTHWEST TEMPORARY PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLIST DETOUR

CORNER MIAMI AND OLD WINDSOR ROADS TEMPORARILY CLOSED FROM 13 MARCH TO 31 MARCH 2017

The \$8.3 billion Sydney Metro Northwest is the first stage of Sydney Metro - Australia's biggest public transport project currently under construction and a priority infrastructure investment for the NSW Government. Salini Impregilo has been contracted to build the 4 kilometre elevated skytrain component of Sydney Metro Northwest, including a new cable stayed bridge over Windsor Road at Rouse Hill.

The works on the corner of Old Windsor Road and Miami Street are almost complete. Final works will be undertaken to the shared path on the western side of Old Windsor Road north of Miami Street **from 13 March to 31 March 2017**, weather permitting. These include:

- Widening of the existing shared path
- Line marketing
- Street light relocation

During these works the shared path will be temporarily closed and detours will be in place.

Pedestrians will be detoured down Miami Street cross left into Tarwin Avenue, left into Abdale Crescent, left into Emmanuel Terrace and right into the access lane to Old Windsor Road. Please see the detour route attached.

Traffic controllers will assist pedestrians during these works including crossing the road at the Miami Street roundabout. We will also have traffic controllers in the access lane during school peak times to assist students safely through the detour.

It will be business as usual at the adjoining retail outlets including KFC, Hungry Jacks and the Caltex petrol station. Pedestrians and cyclists should follow the direction of the traffic controllers on site and take care in the area at all times. The speed limit around the works will be reduced to 40 kph.

We thank you for your understanding and patience and apologise for any inconvenience caused. These works are necessary to improve the footpath and roadway for all users and is part of the Sydney Metro Northwest construction.
