

Sydney Metro is Australia's largest public transport project. It will transform Sydney, delivering more trains and faster services for customers across the network.

This new standalone railway will deliver 31 metro stations and more than 65 kilometres of new metro rail, revolutionising the way Australia's biggest city travels.

Stage 1 of the project, Sydney Metro Northwest, will open in the first half of 2019 and deliver fast, safe and frequent services between Rouse Hill and Chatswood.

Stage 2 Sydney Metro City & Southwest will extend metro rail between Chatswood and Bankstown, including a new crossing beneath Sydney Harbour, new railway stations in the lower North Shore and CBD, and the upgrade and conversion of the current line between Sydenham and Bankstown.

Artarmon Industrial Area Substation

Earlier this year Sydney Metro City & Southwest exhibited the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for Stage 2 of the project.

The EIS included an assessment of the construction and operation of a substation at Barton Road, Artarmon on land near the edge of the Gore Hill Freeway. As a result of feedback received during the EIS public exhibition period, the project has undertaken further design work and identified an alternative location at 98-104 Reserve Road, Artarmon within the Artarmon industrial area (see map overleaf).

The substation is required to supply traction power to the underground metro trains and will include an aboveground building for the substation, electrical equipment and a small shaft for cables to the tunnels below.

Next steps


The project will now continue with further planning including a supplementary environmental assessment which is expected to be finalised by the second quarter of 2017.
