# Sydney Metro West project update

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come.

This once-in-a-century infrastructure investment will provide fast, reliable turn-up-and-go metro services with fully accessible stations, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Sydney Metro West will target an opening date of 2032.

## Construction update

Tunnel Boring Machines (TBMs) have now completed tunnelling on Sydney Metro West, with the final TBM breaking through into the Hunter Street cavern in March 2026. Tunnelling construction teams will remain at several station sites until late 2026 to complete major station excavation works.

Sydney Metro will continue enabling works such as utility relocation across several sites over the coming months to prepare for station construction.

The next phase of the project commenced this month with new contractors taking over several construction sites to begin preparations for station construction, installation of tracks and rail systems, and construction of the stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde. Detailed design work will continue in parallel, prior to major construction. Details about upcoming contracts are provided on the following page.

The community will be notified in advance of upcoming construction activities. Sydney Metro will continue to work closely with all contractors, community and stakeholders to manage construction impacts throughout the works program.

# Major contracts awarded on Sydney Metro West

At the end of 2025, Sydney Metro awarded four key delivery contracts, moving the project into the next stage. Remaining contracts for Pymont, Sydney Olympic Park, and Parramatta are expected to be announced in 2026.

## Linewide

This contract includes laying 60 kilometres of track, the installation of rail systems, ventilation, fire systems and cross passages. The contract also includes the construction of a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde, as well as an Operations Control Centre in the same location.

**John Holland has been awarded the Linewide contract. Site establishment and early works commenced from April 2026.**

## Hunter Street Station and Precinct

Lendlease, Mirvac, and Coombes Property Group have been appointed as Precinct Development Partner for one of the most significant urban renewal projects in the Sydney CBD.

This package involves construction of the underground metro station at Hunter Street and two commercial over-station developments.

**Lendlease is expected to commence construction of the station's main works in early 2027.**

## Trains, Systems, Maintenance and Operations (TSMO)

This is a 22-year contract spanning construction and operational phases, as well as supplying and commissioning 16 new-generation metro trains and systems. The contractor will operate and maintain the Sydney Metro West network for a period of 15 years.

**Metro Trains West Consortium has been awarded the TSMO contract, with work expected to commence on site in 2028.**

## Stations Package West

This contract includes the design and construction of five new underground metro stations at Westmead, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, and The Bays.

**Gamuda has been awarded this contract. Site establishment and early works commenced from April 2026.**
