

Section 81: PID Act 2022

Functions exercised on behalf of Agency

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1. Purpose of the Notice

Under section 81 of the *Public Interest Disclosure Act 2022* (the PID Act), an agency may arrange for another agency or entity to exercise functions on its behalf. The below contains details of the arrangements currently in place for those agencies in scope for Transport's Public Interest Disclosure Procedure. Those agencies are the Department of Transport, Transport for NSW, NSW Motorways, NSW Trains, State Transit Authority of New South Wales, Sydney Ferries, Sydney Metro, Sydney Trains and Transport Asset Manager of New South Wales.

This Notice is published on Transport for NSW's public website and intranet pursuant to s81(4)(a).
