

## Notification – North Strathfield

7 December 2020

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

New metro rail will become the fastest, easiest and most reliable journey between the Sydney and Parramatta CBDs. Sydney Metro West will service the key precincts of Greater Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, The Bays and the Sydney CBD.

Metro services started in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro includes new underground CBD stations at Barangaroo, Martin Place and Pitt Street with new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney Metro will have 31 stations on a new 66km standalone metro rail system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history with ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

### Background noise and vibration monitoring: North Strathfield

Sydney Metro is carrying out attended noise and vibration monitoring in North Strathfield as part of early planning and design work on the project.

These investigations will start on **Monday 14 December for up to one week**, during standard construction hours 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, (weather and site conditions permitting). Each works area may take 1-2 days to complete. Please see map overleaf to inform work location.

Noise and vibration monitors do not record conversations or other sounds and privacy is respected at all times. Monitors inform the frequency, duration and intensity of existing noise and vibration in the area. Personnel will carry identification at all times.

#### Work will involve:

- Setting up noise and vibration monitors on the kerbside to measure noise and ground vibration.

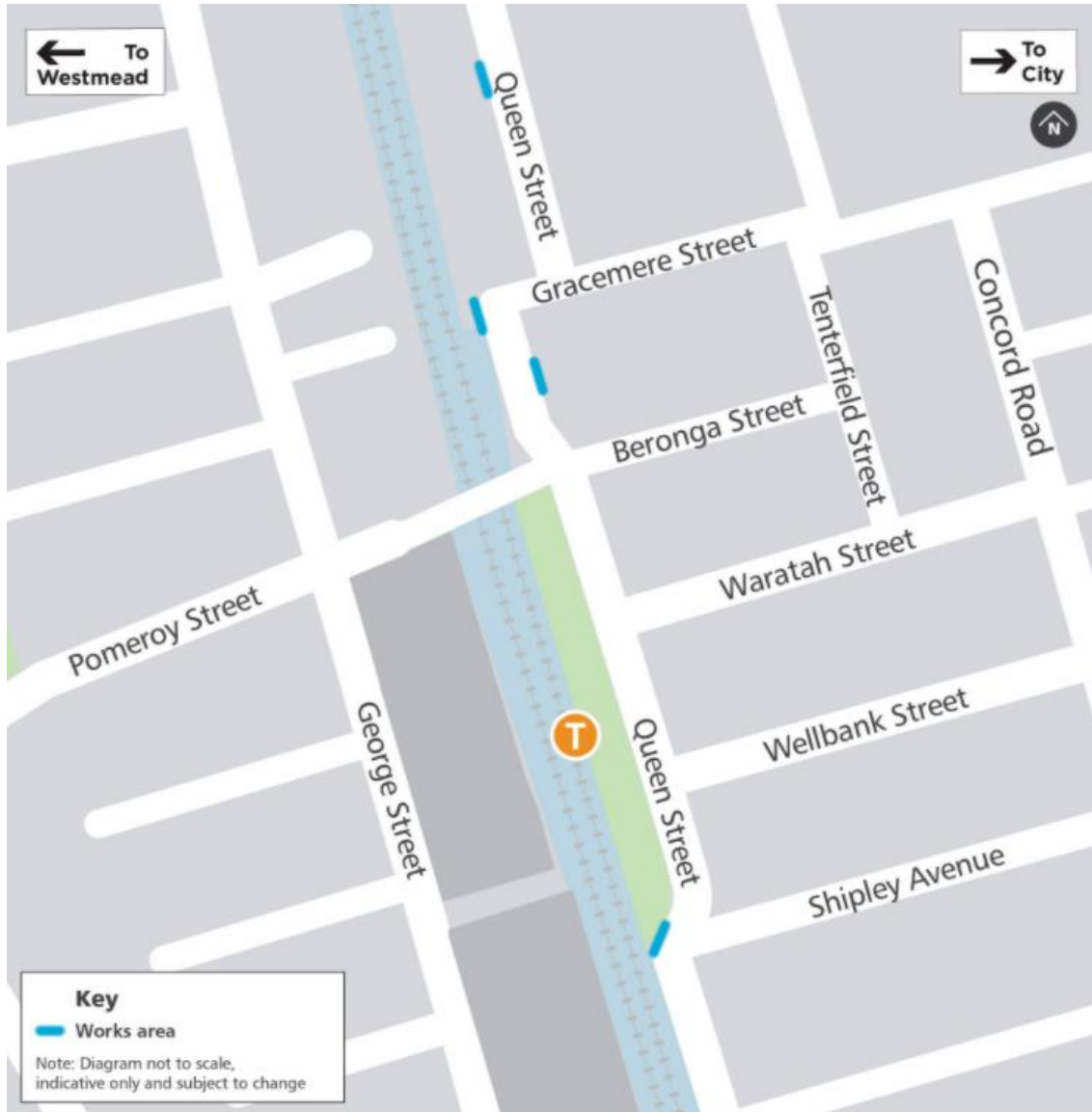
#### What to expect:

- Kerbside parking may be temporarily restricted in some locations
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times for vehicles and pedestrians.

#### Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: hand held monitoring devices, a mounted tripod and light vehicles.
