

Out of hours work notification

September 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66-kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

A W Edwards is building the new Crows Nest Station. Rail track installation is underway, and work to build the station structure is progressing.

Out-of-hours work activities at Crows Nest Station

Standard construction hours at Crows Nest Station site are **Monday to Sunday 7am to 6pm**. Extended hours have been implemented for limited activities within the station box and surrounding streets **up to 12 midnight four nights a week, and up to 10pm every other evening** as detailed in our September 2021 Crows Nest Station monthly update. Working up to 12 midnight may occur up to five nights a week, subject to approval.

In addition to limited activities carried out during our extended hours, the table below lists other planned night work activities for September 2021, their dates, times, location, and further detail. These activities are subject to Public Health Orders, weather and site conditions.

You may notice an increase in concrete trucks travelling to and from the site during this time.

Some of this work will be undertaken within the Crows Nest Station work area (shaded in light blue in the map overleaf) and will involve backfilling and compacting previously excavated electrical pits. An outage will be required on the night, and impacted properties will be notified by Ultegra in advance.

These will be lifted from transport vehicles into our work area via tower crane.



What to expect

- Equipment used will include, but is not limited to, excavators, hand-held and electric tools, cranes, light and heavy vehicles, waste removal trucks, lighting towers and other site lights to provide visibility for workers at night. A mechanical hoist will be in use.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community.
- Other temporary traffic changes may be in place including reduced speed limits, footpath and lane closures.
- While some work will be noisy, the project team will take every step possible to minimise noise impacts.
- Work that is not intrusive may occur outside the dates, locations and times specified in this notification.
