

Notification – Five Dock

20 September 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

This planning determination includes approval to excavate five new metro stations and deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Sydney Olympic Park and The Bays. The contract for this work has been awarded to Acciona Ferrovia Joint Venture (AFJV).

The safety of the community and our workforce is our top priority. All works will be undertaken in line with NSW Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measures and plans.

Site survey and property inspections: Five Dock

Survey work will be undertaken within the future Five Dock station site and surrounding streets to assist with planning and design for Sydney Metro West.

To prepare for the start of construction, essential inspections of Sydney Metro owned properties will also be carried out at the station site. This work is required to assess the presence of hazardous materials on site prior to demolition activities planned to begin early next year.

Work is expected to start on **Monday 27 September 2021** and continue for up to **four (4) weeks** (weather and conditions permitting) during standard construction hours:

- Monday to Friday 7am - 6pm and Saturday 8am - 1pm

The work will involve:

- Visual and topographic survey of existing site conditions using traditional survey equipment
- Capturing details of utility covers, road surfaces, buildings and structures, fences and embankments
- Collecting samples from each property for testing.

What to expect:

- This minimal impact work is not expected to be noisy
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times


Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes handheld survey tools, tripod mounted survey equipment and light vehicles.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Where required, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include hazard signage or stop-slow traffic controls.
