

Notification – additional work hours

September 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

A W Edwards has been awarded the contract to build the new Crows Nest Station. Station box excavation and tunnelling is now complete and rail track installation is underway. A W Edwards has now started work to build the station structure.

Additional work hours at Crows Nest Station

The recent pause on construction and further Public Health Orders and restrictions across Greater Sydney has impacted the schedule of works at this site. As previously advised, Sydney Metro has been reviewing the Crows Nest Station construction schedule to see what changes may be required.

Current approved work hours at the Crows Nest Station site **are 7am to 12am Monday to Thursday and 7am to 10pm every other day**. Working up to 12 midnight may be extended to include Friday night's from Friday 24 September, subject to approval. We will confirm via email if this is approved.

Subject to approval, A W Edwards is also seeking to implement a **6am start time from Monday 27 September**.

If approved, there will be no high noise activities such as rock breaking, rock hammering, sheet piling, pile driving or similar activities taking place during the additional work hour (6am to 7am). Limited non-disruptive activities will be carried out and will include:

- waterproofing, steel fixing, concrete pump set up, installation of inground services, structural steel and formwork.
